1. This invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in UNDB online AFDB517-08/14 of 7/08/2014 on-line and on the African Development Bank Group's Internet Website
2. The Government of Cameroon has received a loan and grant from the African Development Bank in various currencies to finance the cost of the Grassfield Support Project for Rural Infrastructures and Participatory Development (GRASSFIELD II). It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the supply of a palm fruit oil processing line and a palm oil mill.
3. The Grassfield Support Project for Rural Infrastructures and Participatory Development (GRASSFIELD II) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the supply of the following goods (herein called "the Goods")
 - **Supply and installation of palm oil mill in Widikum production basin.**
4. National Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the Bank Rules and Procedures for the Procurement of Goods and Works

7. The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract are the provisions of the African Development Bank Standard Bidding Document: Procurement of Goods.

8. Bids must be delivered to the above office on or before 06/03/2018 at **11:00 a.m.** prompt **and must be accompanied by a security using of 4,000,000 FCFA (Four million francs)**
9. Bids shall remain valid for 120 days after the deadline for the submission prescribed above
10. Bids will be opened in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend, on 06/03/2018 starting **12:00 noon** in the Conference Hall of Grassfield II at the same address.
