- <u>2,3 EVALUATION OF QUOTATIONS:</u> Offers determined to be substantially responsive to the technical specifications will be evaluated by comparison of their prices. An offer is not substantially responsive if it contains material deviations or reservations to the terms, conditions, and specifications in this Request for Quotation, and it will not be considered further. The Contracting Authority will evaluate and compare only the quotations determined to be substantially responsive. In evaluating the quotations, the Contracting Authority will adjust for any arithmetical errors as follows:
 - (a) Where there is a discrepancy between amounts in figures and in words, the amount in words will govern;
 - (b) where there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and the line item total resulting from multiplying the unit rate by the quantity, the unit rate as quoted will govern; and
 - (c) if a Supplier refuses to accept the correction, his quotation will be rejected.
 - In addition to the quoted price, the evaluated price shall include Value Added Tax (VAT) in Cameroon, which will be borne by the state of Cameroon, as IDB financing does not cover the payment of taxes and duties.
 - 2.4 <u>AWARD</u>. The award will be made to the bidder offering the lowest evaluated price that meets the required standards of technical and financial capabilities and within the budget. The successful bidder will sign a Contract as per attached form of contract and terms and conditions of supply.
 - 2,5 <u>VALIDITY OF THE OFFER:</u> Your quotation(s) should be valid for a period of ninety (90) days from the deadline for receipt of quotation(s)
 - 2.6 If you withdraw your quotation during the validity period and/or refuse to accept the award of a contract when and if awarded, then you will be excluded from the list of suppliers for the project for two years.
