#### GENERAL RULES OF THE INVITATION TO TENDER

#### A. General

## Article 1: Scope of the tender

- 1.1 The Contracting Authority as defined in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender here launches an invitation to tender for the construction of the works described in the Tender File a briefly described in the Special Regulations.
- 1.2 The bidder retained or the preferred bidder must complete the works within the time- limit indicated the Special Regulations and which time limit runs from the date of notification of the Administrati Order.
- 1.2 In this Tender File, the term "day" means a calendar day.

#### **Article 2: Financing**

The source of financing of the works forming the subject of this invitation to tender shall be specified in Special Regulations.

#### Article 3: Fraud and corruption

- 3.1 The Contracting Authority requires of bidders and contractors the strict respect of rules of profession ethics during the award and execution of public contracts. By virtue of this principle:
  - a) The following definitions shall be admitted:
    - Shall be guilty of "corruption" whoever offers, gives, requests or accepts any advantage view of influencing the action of a public official during the award or execution of contract;
    - ii) Is involved in "fraudulent manoeuvres" whoever deforms or distorts facts in order influence the award or execution of a contract;
    - iii) "Collusive practices" shall mean any form of agreement between two or among sev bidders (whether the Contracting Authority is aware or not) aimed at artificially maintain the prices of **Bids** at levels not corresponding to those resulting from competition;
    - iv) "Coercive practices" shall mean any form of harm against persons or their property or the against them in order to influence their action during the award or execution of a contract.
    - b) Any proposed award shall be rejected if it is proved that the proposed preferred bidder is directly or through an intermediary, guilty of corruption or is involved in fraudulent manoeur collusive or coercive practices for the award of this contract.
  - 3.2 The Minister Delegate at the Presidency in charge of public contracts may, as a precaution, to decision of exclusion from bidding for a period not exceeding two (2) years against any bidder for guilty of influence peddling, of conflicts of interest, insider trading, fraud, corruption or production non-genuine documents in the bid, without prejudice to criminal proceedings that may be broagainst him

#### Article 4: Candidates allowed competing

- 4.1 If the invitation to tender is restricted, consultation is addressed to all candidates retained after a prequalification procedure.
- 4.2 Generally, the invitation to tender is addressed to all entrepreneurs, subject to the following provisions:
  - (a) A bidder (including all members of a group of enterprises and all sub-contractors to the bidder), in accordance with the funding agreement.
  - (b) A bidder (including all members of a group of enterprises and all sub-contractors to the bidder) must not be in a situation of conflict of interest, subject to disqualification. A bidder shall be judged to be in a situation of conflict of interest if he:
    - i) is or was associated in the past with an enterprise (or a subsidiary of this enterprise) which provided consultancy services for the conception, preparation of specifications and other documents used within the scope of contracts awarded for this invitation to tender; or
      - ii) Presents more than one bid within the context of invitation to tender, except authorised variants according to article 17, where need be; meanwhile, this does not prevent the participation of subcontractors in more than one bid.
    - iii) The Contracting Authority or Project Owner has financial interests in the capital in a way as to compromise the transparency of the procedures of award of public contracts.
  - (c) The bidder must not have been excluded from bidding for public contracts.
  - (d) A Cameroonian public enterprise may participate in the consultation if it can demonstrate that it is (i) legally and financially autonomous, (ii) managed according to commercial laws and (iii) not under the direct supervisory authority of the Contracting Authority or Project Owner.

#### cle 5: Building materials, materials, supplies, equipment and authorised services

- 5.1 Building materials, the contractor's materials, supplies, equipment and services forming the subject of this contract must originate from countries meeting the criteria of origin defined in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender and all expenditure done within the context of the contract shall be limited to the said building materials, materials, supplies, equipment and services.
- 5.2 Within the meaning of this 5.1 above, the term "originate" shall designate the place where the goods are extracted, cultivated, produced, manufactured and from where the services originate.

#### le 6: Qualification of bidder

As an integral part of their bid, bidders must:

- a) submit a power of attorney making the signatory of the bid bound by the bid; and
- b) Provide all information (complete or update information included in their request for prequalification which may have changed in the case where the candidates took part in prequalification) requested of bidders in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender, in order to establish their qualification to execute the contract.

necessary, bidders should provide information relating to the following points:

- The production of certified balance sheets and recent turnovers;
- i) Access to a line of credit or availability of other financial resources;

- (iii) Orders acquired and contracts awarded;
- (iv) Pending litigations;
- (v) Availability of indispensable equipment.
- 6.2 **Bids** presented by two or more associated undertakings (joint contracting) must satisfy the following conditions:
  - (a) The bid must include all the information listed in article 6(1) above. The Special Regulations mu indicate the information to be furnished by the group and that to be furnished by each memb of the group;
  - (b) The bid and the contract must be signed in a way that is binding on all members of the group;
  - (c) The nature of the group (joint or several) must be specified in the Special Regulations and justifi with the production of a joint venture agreement in due form;
  - (d) The member of the group designated as the representative will represent all the undertakings visus the Project Owner and Contracting Authority with regard to the execution of the Contract;
  - (e) In case of joint co-contracting, the co-contractors shall share the sums, which are paid by the Project Owner into a single account. On the other hand, each undertaking is paid into its own account the Project Owner where it is joint co-contracting.
- 6.3 Bidders must equally present sufficiently detailed proposals to demonstrate that they comply with technical specifications and execution time-limits set in the Special Regulations of the invitation tender.
- 6.4 Bidders requesting to benefit from the margin of preference must furnish all the necessinformation to prove that they satisfy the eligibility criteria set in article 33 of the General Regulations the invitation to tender.

#### Article 7: Visit of works site

- 7.1 The bidder is advised to visit and inspect the site and its environs and obtain by himself and under own responsibility, all the information that may be necessary for the preparation of the bid and execution of the works. The related cost of the visit of the site shall be borne by the bidder.
  - 7.2 The Project Owner shall authorise the bidder and his employees or agents to enter the premises at the land for the said visit but only on the express condition that the bidder, his employees and agents the Project Owner, his employees and agents of any responsibility that may ensue and indemnify then necessary and that they shall remain responsible for any deadly or corporal accident, loss or mate damages, costs and fees incurred from this visit.
  - 7.3 The Project Owner may organise a visit of the site of the works during the preparatory meeting establishing the **Bids** mentioned in article 19 of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender.

#### **Article 8: Content of Tender File**

8.1 The Tender File describes the works forming the subject of the contract, sets the consultar procedure of contractors and specifies the terms of the contract. The bidder must examine all the regulations, forms, conditions and specifications contained in the der File. It is up to him to furnish all the information requested and prepare a bid in compliance with all ects of the said file.

#### cle 9: Clarifications on the Tender File and complaints

Any bidder who wants to obtain clarifications on the Tender File may request them from the Contracting tority in writing or by electronic mail (fax or e-mail) at the Contracting Authority's address indicated in Special Regulations of the invitation to tender and send a copy to the Project Owner. The Contracting tority replies in writing to any request for clarification received at least fourteen (14) days prior to the line for the submission of **Bids**.

ppy of the Contracting Authority's response, indicating the question posed but not mentioning the r, is addressed to all bidders who bought the Tender File.

etween the publication of the tender notice including the pre-qualification phase of candidates and the ng of Bids, any bidder who feels aggrieved in the public contracts award procedure may lodge a laint to the Minister in charge of Public Contracts.

copy of the complaint should be addressed to the Contracting Authority and to the body in charge of gulation of public contracts and the chairperson of the Tenders Board.

ne Contracting Authority has five (5) days to react. A copy of the reaction shall be forwarded to IAP and the body in charge of the regulation of public contracts.

#### e 10: Amendment of the Tender File

e Contracting Authority may at any moment, prior to the deadline for the submission of Bids and for son, be it at his initiative or in reply to a request for clarification formulated by a bidder, amend the File by publishing an addendum.

10.2 Any published addendum shall be an integral part of the Tender File, in accordance with article 8.1 the General Regulations of the invitation to tender and must be communicated in writing or made known to a traceable means to all bidders who bought the Tender File.

10.3 In order to give bidders sufficient time to take account of the addendum in the preparation of the Bids, the Contracting Authority may postpone as is necessary, the deadline for the submission of Bids, accordance with provisions of article 22 of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender.

#### C Preparation of Bids

#### Article 11: Tender costs

The candidate shall bear the costs related to the preparation and presentation of his bid and the Contracti Authority and the Project Owner shall in no case be responsible for these costs nor pay for them whatever the evolution or outcome of the invitation to tender procedure.

#### Article 12: Language of Bid

The bid as well as any correspondence and any document exchanged between the bidder and the Contracti Authority shall be written in English or French. Complementary documents and the forms provided by bidder may be written in another language on condition that a precise translation into either English French of the passages concerning the bid is included; in which case for reasons of interpretation, translation shall be considered authentic.

#### Article 13: Constituent documents of the Bid

13.1 The bid presented by the bidder shall include the documents detailed in the Special Regulations of invitation to tender, duly filled and put together in three volumes:

#### a. Volume 1: Administrative file

#### It includes:

- i) all documents attesting that the bidder:
  - has subscribed to all declarations provided for by the laws and regulations in force;
  - paid all taxes, duties, contributions, fees or deductions of whatever nature;
  - is not winding up or bankrupt;
  - is not the subject of an exclusion order or forfeiture provided for by the law in force;
  - ii) The bid bond established in accordance with the provisions of article 17 of the Gen Regulations of the invitation to tender;
  - iii) the written confirmation empowering the signatory of the bid to commit the bidder accordance with the provisions of article 6(1) the General Regulations of invitation to tende

#### b. Volume 2: Technical bid

#### b.1 Information on qualifications

The Special Regulations list the documents to be furnished by bidders to justify the qualification criteria mentioned in article 6(1) of the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender.

#### b.2 Methodology

The Special Conditions of the invitation to tender specifies the constituent elements of the technical bid of the bidders especially: a methodological statement on an analysis of the works and specifying the organisation and programme which the bidder intends to put in place or use to execute the works (installations, schedule, Quality Assurance Plan (QAP), sub-contracting, attestation of visit of the site, where necessary, etc.).

#### b.3 Proof of acceptance of conditions of the contract

The bidder shall submit duly initialled copies of the administrative and technical documents relating to the contract, namely:

- 1. The Special Administrative Conditions (SAC);
- 2. The Special Technical Conditions (STC).

#### b.4 Commentaries (optional)

A commentary on the technical choices of the project and possible proposals.

#### c. Volume 3: Financial bid

- e Special Regulations specify the elements that will help in justifying the cost of the works, namely:
  - 1. The signed and dated original bid prepared according to the attached model, stamped at the prevailing rate;
  - 2. The duly filled Unit Price Schedule;
  - 3. The duly filled detailed estimates;
  - 4. The sub-details of prices and/or breakdown of all-in prices;
  - 5. The projected schedule of payments, where need be.

his regard, the bidders will use the documents and models provided in the Tender File, subject to the visions of article 17(2) of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender concerning the other sible forms of guarantees.

.2 If in accordance with the provisions of the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender, the bidders present **Bids** for several lots of the same invitation to tender, they could indicate rebates offered in case of award of more than one lot.

#### cle 14: Bid price

Except otherwise stated in the Tender File, the amount of the contract shall cover all the works described in article 1.1 of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender, on the basis of the price schedule and the detailed bill of quantities and estimates presented by the bidder.

The bidder shall fill the unit prices and totals of all items on the schedule and bill of quantities and estimates.

Subject to contrary provisions provided for in the Special Regulations and in the Special Administrative Conditions, all dues, taxes and fees payable by the bidder on grounds of the contract or on any other ground, thirty (30) days prior to the submission of the Bids, shall be included in the prices and in the total amount of the bid presented by the bidder.

If a price revision/updating clause is provided for in the contract, the date of establishment of the initial price, as well as the price revision/updating conditions for the said price must be specified. This is with the understanding that any contract of duration less than one (1) year shall not be subject to price revision.

14.5 All unit prices must be justified by sub-details established in accordance with the structure propos in document 8 of the Tender File.

#### Article 15: Currency of bid and payment

- 15.1 In case of international invitations to tender, the currencies of the bid shall follow the provisions either Option A or Option B below, the applicable option being that retained in the Special Regulatio of the invitation to tender.
- 15.2 Option A: The amount of the bid shall be entirely made in the national currency.

The amount of the bid, unit prices of the price schedule and the prices of the bill of quantities a estimates are completely made in CFA francs in the following manner:

- a) Prices shall be entirely drawn in the national currency. The bidder who intends to commexpenditures in other currencies for the execution of the works shall indicate in the annex to a bid the percentage(s) of the amount of the bid necessary to cover the needs in foreign currenci without exceeding the maximum of the three currencies of member countries of the fundi institution of the contract.
- b) The exchange rates used by the bidder to convert his bid into the national currency shall specified by the bidder in an annex to the bid in compliance with the specifications of the Spec Regulations. #### Article 16: Validity of Bids

- 16.1 Bids must remain valid during the period stated in the Special Regulations from the date of submission the Bids fixed by the Contracting Authority, in application of article 22 of the Special Regulations. The bid bond of the successful bidder shall be released as soon as the latter would have signed the contract and furnished the required final bond.

- (b) if the retained bidder:

- ii) fails in his obligation to furnish the required final bond in application of article 38 of the General Regulations;
- iii) Refuses to receive notification of the Administrative Order to commence execution.

#### 18: Varying proposals of bidders

xcept in the case mentioned in article 18(3) below, bidders wishing to offer technical variants must sess the basic solution of the Contracting Authority as described in the Tender File and furnish in all the information which the Contracting Authority needs for a complete evaluation of the ed variant, including the plans, calculations, technical specifications, sub-details of prices and

proposed construction methods and all other useful information. If necessary, the Contracting Authority we examine only the technical variants of the bidder whose bid is in compliance with the basic solution has be evaluated as the lowest bid.

18.3 When according to the Special Regulations the bidders are authorised to directly submit the technic variants for certain parts of the works, these parts of the works must be described in the technic specifications. Such variants shall be evaluated on their own merit in accordance with the provisions of artic 31(2) (g) of the General Regulations.

#### Article 19: Preparatory meeting to the establishment of Bids

- 19.1 Except otherwise stipulated in the Special Regulations, a bidder may be invited to take part in preparatory meeting which will hold at the date and place indicated in the Special Regulations.
- 19.2 The subject of the preparatory meeting shall be to furnish clarifications and answer any questions, whi may be raised at this stage.
- 19.3 As much as possible, the bidder is requested to submit any question in a way as to reach the Contracti Authority at least one week before the meeting The Contracting Authority may not reply to question received too late. In this case, the questions and answers shall be transmitted according to the method set in article 19(4) below.
- 19.4 The minutes of the meeting, including the text of the questions asked and the replies given, including questions prepared after the meeting, shall be forwarded immediately to everyone who bought a Tender File. Any modification of documents of the Tender File listed in article 8 of the Gene Regulations which may prove to be necessary at the end of the preparatory meeting shall be done the Contracting Authority by publishing an addendum in accordance with the provisions of article of the General Regulations and not through the minutes of the preparatory meeting.
- 19.5 The fact that a bidder does not attend a preparatory meeting for the establishment of **Bids** shall not b reason for disqualification.

#### Article 20: Form and signature of bid

- 20.1 The bidder shall prepare an original of the constituent documents described in article 13 of the Gene Regulations in a volume clearly indicated "ORIGINAL". In addition, the bidder shall submit number required in the General Regulations, bearing "COPY". In case of discrepancy, the original sl be considered as authentic.
- 20.2 The original and copies of the bid must be typed or written in indelible ink (photocopies shall accepted in the case of copies) and shall be signed by the person(s) duly empowered to sign on behalf the bidder, in accordance with article 6(1a) or 6(2c) of the General Regulations, as the case may be, the pages of the bid containing alterations or changes must be initialled by the signatory (ies) of the bid
- 20.3 The bid shall be bearing no modification, suppression or alteration unless such corrections are initial by the signatory(ies) of the bid.

#### D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

### Article 21: Sealing and marking of Bids

21.1 The bidder shall seal the original and each copy of the bid in separate envelopes (internal envelopes) marking on these envelopes "ORIGINAL" and "COPY", as the case may be. The envelopes shall to be placed in another envelope which will equally be sealed but which will not give any indicate regarding the identity of the bidder.

2 The external and internal envelopes:

- a) Should be addressed to the Contracting Authority at the address indicated in the Special Regulations;
- b) should bear the name and identification number of the project as indicated in the Special Regulations and bear the inscription "TO BE OPENED ONLY DURING THE BID-OPENING SESSION" as specified in the Special Regulations.

If the external envelope is not sealed and marked as indicated in paragraphs 21(1) and 21(2) above, the Contracting Authority shall not be responsible if the bid is misplaced or opened prematurely.

#### cle 22: Date and time limit for submission of Bids

#### le 23: Late Bids

Any bid received by the Contracting Authority beyond the deadline for the submission of **Bids** in accordance with article 22 of the General Regulations shall be declared late and consequently rejected.

#### e 24: Modification, substitution and withdrawal of Bids

bidder may modify or withdraw his bid after submitting it, on condition that the written notification of he modification or withdrawal is received by the Contracting Authority prior to the end of the time limit prescribed for the submission of the **Bids**. The said notification must be signed by an authorised epresentative in application of article 20(2) of the General Regulations. The modification or the corresponding replacement bid must be attached to the written notification. As the case may be, the nvelopes must bear the inscription "WITHDRAWAL", and "REPLACEMENT BID" or MODIFICATION".

otification of modification, replacement or withdrawal of the bid by the bidder should be prepared, ealed, marked and forwarded in accordance with the provisions of article 21 of the General Regulations. Vithdrawal may equally be notified by telex but should in this case be confirmed by a duly signed ritten notification whose date, postmark being authentic, shall not be posterior to the time-limit set for the submission of **Bids**.

application of article 24(1), Bids being requested to be withdrawn by bidders shall be returned to them opened.

bid may be withdrawn during the interval between the submission of **Bids** and the expiry of the lidity of **Bids** specified by the model tender. The withdrawal of a bid by a bidder during this interval by lead to the confiscation of the bid bond in accordance with the provisions of article 17(6) of the neral Regulations.

#### E. Opening of envelopes and evaluation of Bids

#### Article 25: Opening of envelopes and petitions

- 25.1 The competent Tenders Board shall open the envelopes in single phase and in the presence of trepresentatives of bidders who wish to attend at the date, time and address specified in the Spec Regulations. Representatives of bidders shall sign a register attesting to their presence.
- 25.2 Firstly, envelopes marked "withdrawal" shall be opened and the contents announced to the hearing everyone, while the envelope containing the corresponding bid shall be returned to the bidder unopened. - 25.3 All envelopes shall be opened successively and the name of the bidder announced aloud as well as possible modification mentioned, the price offered, including any rebates [in case of opening of financ Bids] and any variant, where necessary, the existence of a guarantee of the bid if it is required and a other details which the Contracting Authority deems useful to be mentioned. Only rebates and varia of Bids announced to the hearing of everyone during the opening of Bids shall be submitted evaluation.
- 25.4 **Bids** (and modifications received in accordance with the provisions of article 24 of the Gene Regulations) which were not opened and read to the hearing of everyone during the bid-opening sess: for whatever reason, shall not be submitted for evaluation.
- 25.5 Bid-opening minutes are recorded on the spot mentioning the admissibility of Bids, their administrat regularity, prices, rebates and time-limits as well as the composition of the Evaluation sub-committee copy of the said minutes to which is attached the attendance sheet is handed over to all the participants the end of the session.
- 25.6 At the end of each bid-opening session, the chairperson of the Tenders Board immediately hands over the focal point designated by the body in charge of regulation of public contract an initialled copy of Bids presented by bidders.
- 25.7 In case of petition as provided for by the Public Contracts Code, it should be addressed to the Minis Delegate in charge of Public Contracts with copies to the body in charge of the regulation of pul contracts, the head of structure to which is attached the Tenders Board concerned.
  It must reach within a maximum deadline of three (3) working days after the opening of Bids in the form of a letter to which is obligatorily attached a sheet of the petition form duly signed by the petitioner possibly by the chairperson of the Tenders Board.

The Independent Observer attaches to his report the sheet that was handed to him, including any relacommentaries or observations.

#### Article 26: Confidential nature of the procedure

26.1 No information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of Bids verification of the qualification of the bidders and the recommendation for the award shall be given

bidders or to any person not concerned with the said procedure as long as the preferred bidder has not been made public, subject to the disqualification of the bid of the bidder and suspension of the authors from all activities in the domain of public contracts.

This request for clarification and the response thereto are formulated in writing but no change on the amount or content of the bid is sought, offered or authorised, except it is necessary to confirm the correction of calculation errors discovered by the Evaluation Sub-committee during the evaluation in accordance with the provisions of article 30 of the General Regulations.

Subject to the provisions of paragraph 1 above, bidders shall not contact members of the Tenders Board and the Evaluation Sub-committee for questions related to their **Bids**, between the opening of envelopes and the award of the contract.

#### le 28: Determination of compliance of Bids

The Evaluation sub-committee shall carry out a detailed examination of **Bids** to determine if they are complete, if the required guarantees are furnished, if the documents were correctly signed and if generally the **Bids** are in proper order.

he Evaluation sub-committee shall determine if the bid is essentially in compliance with the conditions fixed in the Tender File based on the content without recourse to external elements of proof.

bid that complies with the Tender File shall essentially be a bid that respects all the terms, conditions and specifications of the Tender File, without substantial divergence or reservation. A substantial livergence or reservation is that:

- i) which substantially limits the scope, quality or realisation of the works;
- ii) which substantially limits, contrary to the Tender File, the rights of the Contracting Authority or his obligations in relation to the contract;
- iii) Whose correction would unjustly affect the competitiveness of the other bidders who presented **Bids** that essentially complied with the Tender File.

f a bid is essentially not in compliance, it shall be rejected by the competent Tenders Board and shall not subsequently be rendered in compliance.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any modification, divergence or reservation. Modifications, divergences, variants and other factors, which are beyond the requirements of the Tender File, shall not be considered during the evaluation of **Bids**.

#### 29: Qualification of the bidder

he Evaluation sub-committee shall ensure that the successful bidder retained for having submitted a id substantially in compliance with the provisions of the Tender File, fulfils the qualification criteria

stipulated in article 6 of the Special Regulations. It is essential to avoid any arbitrariness determining qualification.

#### **Article 30: Correction of errors**

- 30.1 The Evaluation sub-committee shall verify **Bids** considered essentially in compliance with the Tend File to correct the possible calculation errors. The Evaluation sub-committee shall correct the errors the following manner:

  - 30.3 If the bidder who presented the bid evaluated as the lowest refuses the correction thus carried out, bid shall be rejected and the bid bond may be seized.

## Article 31: Conversion into a single currency

- 31.1 To facilitate the evaluation and comparison of **Bids**, the Evaluation sub-committee shall convert prices of **Bids** expressed in various currencies into those in which the bid is payable in CFA francs.
- 31.2 The conversion shall be done using the selling rate fixed by the Bank of Central African States (BEA under the conditions defined by the Special Regulations.

## Article 32: Evaluation and comparison of financial Bids

- Only **Bids** considered as being in compliance, as per the provisions of article 28 of the Gene Regulations, shall be evaluated and compared by the Evaluation sub-committee.
- 32.2 By evaluating the **Bids**, the Evaluation Sub-committee shall determine for each bid the evalua amount of the bid by rectifying the amount as follows:
  - a) By correcting any possible error in accordance with the provisions of article 30.2 of the Gene Regulations;
  - b) By excluding projected sums and where necessary provisions for unforeseen occurrences feature in the bill of quantities and estimates but by adding the amount of works done under St supervision where they are costed in a competitive manner as specified in the Special Regulation
  - c) By converting into a single currency, the amount resulting from the rectifications (a) and (b) abo in accordance with the provisions of article 31(2) of the General Regulations;
  - d) By appropriately adjusting any other modification, divergence or quantifiable reservation technical or financial basis.

- e)By taking into consideration the various execution time-limits proposed by the bidders, if they are authorised by the Special Regulations;
- f) If need be, in accordance with the provisions of article 13(2) of the General Regulations and the Special Regulations by applying the rebates offered by the bidder for the award of more than one lot, if this invitation to tender is launched simultaneously for several lots.
- g) If need be, in accordance with the provisions of article 18(3) of the Special Regulations and the Technical Specifications, the proposed technical variants, if they are permitted, shall be evaluated on their own merit and independently of the fact that the bidder offered or not a price for the technical solution specified by the Contracting Authority in the Special Regulations.
- 2.3 The estimated effect of price revision formulae featuring in the GAC and SAC applied during the period of execution of the contract shall not be considered during the evaluation of Bids.
- 1.4 If the bid judged the lowest bid is considered abnormally low or strongly unbalanced in relation to the estimates of the Project Owner for the works to be executed in this contract, the Tenders Board may, from the sub-details of prices furnished by the bidder for any element or all the elements of the bill of quantities and estimates, verify if these prices are compatible with the construction methods and proposed calendar. In the case where the justifications presented by the bidder are not satisfactory, the Contracting Authority may reject the bid after the technical opinion of the Public Contracts Regulatory Agency.

#### ticle 33: Preference granted national bidders

National contractors shall benefit from a margin of national preference during the evaluation of Bids as provided for in the Public Contracts Code.

#### le 34: Award

The Contracting Authority shall award the contract to the bidder whose bid was judged essentially in compliance with the Tender File and who has the required technical and financial capacities to execute the contract satisfactorily and whose bid was evaluated as the lowest by including, where necessary, proposed rebates

If, according to article 13(2) of the General Regulations, the invitation to tender comprises several lots, the lowest bid shall be determined by evaluating this contract with other lots to be awarded concurrently, by taking into account the rebates offered by the bidders in the case of more than one lot.

Any award of contract shall be made to the bidder fulfilling the technical and financial capacities required resulting from the evaluation criteria and presenting the bid evaluated as the lowest.

# 35: The right by the Contracting Authority to declare an invitation to tender unsuccessful or cancel a procedure

ontracting Authority reserves the right to cancel a procedure of invitation to tender after the sation of the Minister Delegate at the Presidency in charge of Public Contracts where the **Bids** have pened or to declare an invitation to tender unsuccessful after the advice of the competent Tenders without any claims being entertained.

#### 36: Notification of award of the contract

the expiry of the validity of the **Bids** set in the Special Regulations, the Contracting Authority shall he preferred bidder by telecopy confirmed by registered mail or by any other means that his bid was . This letter will indicate the amount the Project Owner will pay the contractor to execute the works execution time-limit.

## Article 37: Publication of results of award and petitions

- 37.1 The Contracting Authority shall communicate to any bidder or administration concerned, upon requaddressed to it within a maximum deadline of five (5) days after publication of the award results, to Independent Observer's report as well as the minutes of the award session of the related contract to whishall be attached the evaluation report of the **Bids**.
- 37.2 The Contracting Authority is bound to communicate the reasons for the rejection of **Bids** of the bidders concerned whom so request.
- 37.3 After publication of the award results, **Bids** that are not withdrawn within fifteen (15) days shall destroyed, without any claims for compensation being entertained. Only the copy destined for the body charge of regulation shall be kept.
- 37.4 In case of petition, it should be addressed to the Public Contracts Authority, with copies to the body charge of the regulation of public contracts, the Contracting Authority and the chairperson of the Tend Board concerned.

It must take place within a maximum deadline of five (5) working days after the publication of the results.

## Article 38: Signing of the contract

- 39.3 Small and medium-sized enterprises (SME) constituted of national capital and managed by nation may, in lieu of the guarantee, provide a statutory lien or a bond issued by a banking establishment first-rate financial institution approved in accordance with the instruments in force.
- Failure to produce the final bond within the prescribed time limit shall likely cause the termination the contract under the terms laid down in the General Administrative Conditions.

This consist of the supply and putting in place of rain gates using I-BEAM 200 for the standing pole with three standing poles providing space for light vehicles the width of which will be specified by th Contract Engineer and on the execution plans. A horizontal pipe will be anchored to one of the extrem standing I-BEAM to form a pivot such that the pipe can be locked on the central I-BEAM. Therefore provision will be made at the central beam for the locking and opening of the gate.

#### 12) TM602 -Provision for relocation of utilities (water supply network pipes)

This consist of identifying the positions of pipes along the road alongside the village water managen committee chair or his duly mandated representative and causing this committee through his chair to free pipes or any other accessories from the right of way of the road for works to be executed. The chairper will jointly with the contractor, the Contract Engineer evaluate the works to be executed and materials plabour will be provided by the contractor for the works that will be realised by the water committee againstifications. These expenses will be majorated by the indirect charges of the enterprise for her payment.

#### 13) SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

Safety measures shall be put in place to safeguard the health of the workers. They shall be equipped a personal protective equipment like helmets, boots, gloves, goggles, rain coats etc. a first aid box shall provided on the site to render first aid services in case of any accident. Before the start of each task, workshall be reminded of the potential hazards associated to that task and the safety measures to be taken to as possible accidents. Working points shall be well signalized to road users using sign boards placed adequate positions that can be visible to everybody.

Every area from which soil is to be extracted shall be covered with vegetative soil at the end of the jo facilitate the growth of vegetation and to avoid erosion.
