xxx). Or the indication of their rejection including the reasons for the said rejection.

The Contractor has eight (8) days to present a new draft. The Contract Engineer then has a deadline of five (5) days to give his approval or possibly make comments. Delay in approving the draft execution schedule shall stay the execution deadline.

The approval given by the Contract Engineer does not in any way release the Contractor of his responsibilities. Meanwhile, works executed before the approval of the programme shall neither be ascertained nor paid for. The updated and approved schedule will become the Contractual schedule.

The Contractor shall constantly update on site, a schedule that will take account of real progress of the site. Significant modifications may only be made on the Contractual programme upon receiving the approval of the Contract Engineer. After approval of the execution schedule by the Contract Engineer, the latter shall transmit it within five (5) days to the Contracting Authority without staying its execution. However, if important modifications alter the objective of the Contract or the nature of the works, the Contracting Authority shall return the execution schedule accompanied by reservations to be lifted within fifteen (15) days of the date of reception.

- b) The Environment Management Plan should bring out notably the choice technical conditions of the site and basic life, conditions of the backfill of the extraction sites and conditions for reinstating the works and installation sites.
- c) The Contractor shall indicate in this schedule the equipment and methods which he intends to use as well as the personnel he intends to employ.
- d) The approval granted by the Contract Engineer shall in no way diminish the responsibility of the Contractor with regard to the harmful consequences which their implementation may cause both towards third parties and the respect of clauses of the Contract.

#### 35.2 Execution draft

- a) The execution plan documents (calculations and drawings) necessary for the realisation of all the parts of the structure must be submitted for the endorsement of the [Contract Engineer] at most fifteen (15) days prior to the date provided for the commencement of execution of the corresponding part of the structure.
- b) The [Contract Engineer] has a deadline of [five (05) days] to examine and make known his observations. The Contractor then has a deadline of (04) four days to present a new file including the said observations.

These operations shall be subject to a site report drawn up on the field, signed by the following.

During this pre-acceptance, the Contract Engineer shall eventually specify the reserves to be lifted and the corresponding works to be effected before the reception. The Contract Engineer shall fix the reception date in collaboration with the chairman of the acceptance commission.

#### 42.2 Provisional Acceptance

The acceptance commission shall comprise:

- 1- The Authorizing Officer (project Owner) or his representative ........... (Chairman)
- 2- The Contract Engineer or his representative.....(Secretary)
- 3- The DD of MINMAP Mezam or his representative......(Observer)
- 5- The CDO Bamenda III......(Member)

- 7- The Contractor or his Representative....... (Member)

The commission shall examine the report of the pre-acceptance and shall proceed to the provisional acceptance. A provisional acceptance report (process - verbal) of the works shall be prepared by the Engineer and sign by all the commission members.

#### Article 43: GUARANTEE PERIOD.

The guarantee period is six (06) months from the date of the provisional acceptance for the section of rehabilitation of buildings and not applicable for equipment.

### Article 44: Article 45: Final acceptance (article 72 of the GAC)

- 44.1 The Final acceptance shall take place within a maximum deadline of **fifteen** (15)days from the date of expiry of the guarantee period.
- 44.2 The Project Manager shall not be member of the final acceptance commission.

The procedure for final acceptance shall be the same as for provisional acceptance.

#### CHAPTER V: MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

#### Article 45: Termination of the Contract (article 74 of the GAC)

#### **GENERALITIES**

These descriptive notes and technical specifications are drawn up for the purpose of REHABILITATION OF TWO (02) BLOCKS OF FIVE (05) CLASSROOMS AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FENCE WALL OF 80M AT GOVERNMENT PRACTICING SCHOOL NIBUNG IN BAMENDA III SUB-DIVISION IN MEZAM DIVISION. This descriptive note is for those to execute, supervise and the client, to direct and guide them towards quality choice of materials, method of job execution and conditions of execution in order to achieve this highly desired goal. Also these descriptive notes are for those to execute, supervise and the contractor, to direct and guide them towards quality choice of materials, method of job execution and conditions of execution in order to achieve this highly desired goal. Building materials concerned are generally what is accepted in the construction industry and only qualified technicians are required to transform these materials into the desire finished works.

#### PLANNING AND SITE ORGANIZATION

Careful forethought and planning are required for sound site organization. Consideration must be given to the efficient use of available space at the site during building operations in order to ensure that all building activities move smoothly with minimal interference or delay. The proper choice of suppliers and subcontractors plays an important part in achieving desired quality and efficiency.

# THE REHABILITATION PROCESS AND SUPERVISION

Reliable standards must be maintained throughout the whole rehabilitation process in order to ensure that the rehabilitated work is durable, is functionally sound and aesthetically satisfying. Simple time-tested methods that have proved effective in ensuring quality can be employed to make sure that problems do not develop later, which can be expensive and difficult to rectify. #### **II.2 MASONRY AND CONCRETE WORKS**

- **Sand:** Will be free from oxide, organic material of animals or plant origin. Sieving shall vary from 0.08 2.5mm for mortar and other resisting surfaces like concrete structure shall vary from 0.16 5mm. It shall be river sand and nothing else.
- Aggregate shall consist of crush stones. Tiny layer of grave (dust) shall be removed through blowing or washing.
- Water: To be used for mixture mortar, concrete and aggregate washing most be free from impurities and salts.
- **Cement:** To be used mostly for cement mortar, concrete shall satisfy the general conditions laid down by regulation in force. It will type CPJ325 Portland cement from CIMENCAM and shall not show any trace of mixture. Storage on the building site shall be done on a dry and ventilated floor. - Doors- All metallic doors will be made of iron tubes framesandmetal sheetswith all accessories fitted on metallic or wooden frames and chocked with rich concrete in the wall.
- Size: 150x210

- Frame: angle bar of 35mm
- Shutter: will be square 30mm+ black steel plated 10/10 on double faces + 3 pairs of hinges and a canon vachette lock and iron staple bolts.
- ii. Window protectors They shall be of square tubes of 25x25x2mm framed with angle bar of 25x2mm. It shall be treated with antirust and shall be fixed on the window frames made of hard mood and well moulded following the dimensions.

#### I.4. ALUMINIUM WORKS

All windows frames and external covers shall be of aluminium and in the frames shall be fitted glass of approved quality.

# 1.5 PAINTING AND DECORATION

All the surfaces to be painted shall be cleaned, and prime with ordinary paint (universal 10000). The painting shall be done in two coats according to the following specification:

- Internal walls with pantex 800
- External walls with pantex 1300 vinyl type
- Metallic elements with oil paints(glycerol)
- Wooden works shall be of vanish

#### 1.6 ELECTRICITY

The electricity installation shall be in conformity with the electrical plan approved of by the Control Engineer. The contractor shall connect the installation to the existing AES SONEL network in the institution. Flexible orange conduits pipes of adequate diameter shall be used, and must be buried inside the walls (blocks). As a general rule cables of section 1.5mm² shall be used for the lighting circuit while that of sockets shall be of section 2.5mm². #### **1.8 DRAINAGE WORKS**

# II- CONSTRUCTION OF A FENCE 80M II.1 PREPARATORY WORKS

**SETTING OUT:** The setting out will be in respect to the technical plans.

The setting out profile boards will be at least 1, 20 m from the outside axes, this to facilitate trenching and other earthworks and good circulation. The commencement of excavation will be accepted by the Project Engineer without checking the conformity of the setting.

The minimal depth of the excavation trenches shall be of 80cm, and depending on the soil bearing capacity. Where there is black cotton soil or soil with low bearing capacity at the bottom of the trench, the contractor shall continue excavation up to a depth as will be approved by the Project Engineer. The excavations will be done manually and no concrete or mortar shall be laid on the bottom of the trench without the acceptance of the trench bottom of excavation by the Project Engineer.

The descriptive notice completes or confirms the indications on the execution plans. In the case of contradictions between the plans and the descriptive notice, the project team shall be contacted for examination, elaboration and conclusion.

These technical specifications have as objective the definition of the consistence of works to be executed in accordance with the plans and according to technical norms for the construction of classroom buildings.

#### II.2- FOUNDATION:

**Blinding concrete:** The base of the foundation trenches shall be stabilized with 5cm of concrete dosed at 150kg/m3

**ELEVATION WORKS:** The elevation walls be in agglomerated hollow blocks of  $15 \times 20 \times 40$ cm with a good crushing resistance.
