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CONSULTATION NOTICE

1- Purpose of the consultation:

The Mayor of the Commune of Bangangté is launching a consultation For the provision of teaching equipment for three (03) community pre-school centres (Mango, Bangoua, Bantoum) Lot 1;

Acquisition of equipment for the pre-collection of household waste Lot 2;

Medical equipment for the Banékane, Kafeng and Bahouoc CSIs Lot 3.

2- Participation and origin: This consultation is open to all Cameroonian companies operating in this field of activity.

3- Financing: The service covered by this consultation is financed by the public investment budget (BIP), financial year 2024, for a provisional cost of twelve million (12,000,000) CFA francs inclusive of all taxes for Lot 1; twenty million one hundred thousand (20,100,000) CFA francs inclusive of all taxes for Lot 2 and twenty million (20,000,000) CFA francs inclusive of all taxes for Lot 3.

4- Consultation of the file: The request for quotation file can be consulted during working hours at the procurement department of the Bangangté Commune as soon as this notice is published, Tel: 675 16 93 99/ 695 98 36 36.

5- Acquiring the consultation file: The consultation file can be obtained from the Bangangté City Council Procurement Department, on presentation of a non-refundable receipt for payment of the sum of Sixty Thousand (60,000) CFA Francs, payable to the Bangangté Municipal Revenue Office.

6- Submission of tenders: Each tender, drawn up in French or English in seven (07) copies, the original and six (06) copies marked as such, must reach the Bangangté Town Hall no later than **19 April at 08:00** local time in a sealed envelope. No bids will be accepted after this time. No tender duly submitted may be modified or withdrawn and must bear the words :

7- Admissibility of bids: Each bidder must attach to his administrative documents a bid bond in the amount of Two Hundred and Forty Thousand (240,000) CFA francs for lot 1; Four Hundred and

Twenty Thousand (420,000) CFA francs for lot 2 and Four Hundred Thousand (400,000) CFA francs for lot 3, issued by a first class bank or insurance company approved by the Ministry of Finance and valid for thirty (30) days beyond the original date of validity of the bids.

N/B: No person may be awarded more than two lots.

The list of approved banks appears in the annex to the consultation file. The other administrative documents required must be produced in originals or in copies certified as true by the issuing department, in accordance with the stipulations of the consultation regulations, otherwise they will be rejected. They must be dated less than three (03) months.

8- Opening of bids: The bids will be opened at one time on **19 April at 09.00** local time by the Bangangté Internal Contract Award Commission in the Bangangté Town Hall. Tenderers or their duly authorised representatives with proof of their mandate may attend the bid opening session.

9- Delivery time: The maximum delivery time is three (03) months for each lot from the date of notification of the service order.

10- Tender evaluation criteria

Eliminatory criteria:

The eliminatory criteria set the minimum conditions to be met in order to be admitted to the evaluation according to the essential criteria. Failure to comply with these criteria will result in the tenderer's offer being rejected.

These include

- a) Absence of the bid bond when the bids are opened;
- b) Failure to regularise a non-compliant administrative document after 48 hours;
- c) Falsified document or previously certified document and/or false declaration;
- d) Failure to present a photocopy of the DAO purchase receipt when submitting bids to the project owner's contracting department;
- e) Incomplete technical offer due to the absence of the site visit report signed on honour by the tenderer;
- f) Omission from the financial offer of a unit price quantified in the BPU and DQE;
- g) Failure to satisfy at least 70% of the essential criteria evaluated according to the scoring grid;
- h) No declaration that it has not abandoned work in the last two (02) years and that it is not on the list of companies suspended by the Public Procurement Authority.

11- The Contracting Authority will award the Contract to the tenderer whose tender is judged to be the lowest bid and complies with the technical specifications.

12- Period of validity of tenders: Tenderers shall remain bound by their tender for a period of ninety (90) days from the deadline set for the submission of tenders.
