- 1. Subject of the invitation to tender: Within the framework of the execution of the 2024 State Budget, the Mayor Muyuka council hereby launches by emergency procedure, an open national invitation to tender FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE BAVENGA-IKATA INTEGRATED HEALTH CENTER
- 2. Nature of works: The works comprise notably:

This involves the realisation of the tasks outlined in the bills of quantities and cost estimates and elaborated in the special technical clauses comprising notably:

- 3. Execution deadline: The maximum duration of execution provided for by the Contracting Authority is three (03) months. This duration is as from the date of notification of the service order to start work.

4. Number of Lots

The works which are subject of this invitation to tender are grouped into one Lot;

5. Estimated cost

The estimated cost after preliminary studies stands at Fifteen million (15.000.000) FCFA.

6. Participation and origin

The tender is open to duly registered Cameroonian Enterprises that fulfil the requirements of this invitation to tender.

7. Financing

8. Bid bond:

Each bidder must include in his/her administrative documents, a bid bond that respects the models of this tender file, issued by a first-rate banking establishment approved by the Ministry in charge of finance, (see list in document No. 12 of this tender file), of an amount of **three hundred thousand (300.000) FCFA.**

Bid bonds for unsuccessful bidders shall be withdrawn not later than fifteen (15) days after the award of the contract and those of successful bidder shall be retained until the required performance guarantee for good execution is provided.

9. Consultation of tender file:

The tender file may be consulted during working hours at Muyuka council secretariat.

10. Acquisition of tender file:

The tender file may be acquired from the Muyuka council; upon presentation of a nonrefundable treasury receipt (payable at the Council Treasury) of Fifty Thousand (50.000) FCFA. Such a receipt shall identify the concerned bidder.

11. Submission of bids:

Each bid drafted in English or French shall be signed by the bidder or by a duly authorized representative and presented in seven (07) copies including the original and six (06) copies marked as such. These shall be submitted in one sealed pack containing three (3) envelopes; (A: Administrative file, B: Technical file, C: Financial file). The sealed pack shall bear no information on the enterprise, and should reach the Office of the Muyuka council latest the

In case of any ambiguities or differences, only the original shall be considered authentic.

12. Admissibility of bids

Any bid that does not respect the mode of separation of the financial, administrative and technical bids shall be rejected.

Any bid not in compliance with the prescriptions of the Tender File shall be declared inadmissible. This refers especially to the absence of a bid bond issued by a first-rate bank approved by the Minister in charge of Finance. Notably, the absence of bid bond delivered by a first order bank approved by the Minister in charge of Finance valid for thirty (30) days after the validity of bids.

Under penalty of being rejected, only originals or true copies certified by the issuing service or administrative authorities and must imperatively be produced in accordance with the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender. They must obligatorily be not older than three (3) months before the latest date set for the opening of bids. Cumulative bidding shall not be accepted.

13. Opening of bids:

prompt in the Conference Hall of the Muyuka council Internal Tender's board. Only bidders may attend or be duly represented by a person of their choice, who has a full

knowledge of the file and mandated in that capacity.

14. Evaluation criteria

The evaluation of bids shall be carried out in three stages:

- Stage: verification of the presence and conformity of each administrative
- 2nd Stage: Evaluation of the technical bids;
- > 3rd Stage: Analyses of the financial bids.

The criteria of evaluation shall be as follows:

14.1-Eliminatory criteria

- Absence of administrative document, the bidder is given 48 hours following the opening of bids to provide;
- Deadline of execution more than the prescribed duration
- False declaration or falsified or scanned documents;
- Absence or insufficient bid bond:
- Omission of a quantified task on the bill of quantities and cost estimates
- Enterprise with history of an abandoned contract or uncompleted project (above 10% lateness penalties without due justification) in the South west Region.
- Non satisfaction of at least 75% of the main qualification criteria.
- 14.2. Main qualification criteria: The evaluation of the bids shall be done on predefined technical criteria on a global mark of 100. The criteria relating to the qualification of candidates could indicatively be on the following:
