I. Context and justification

Daily accounts on road accidents in Cameroon are abundant. Despite vigorous efforts by the public authorities to fight against road insecurity, there are still deaths due to road accidents on our roads.

In effect, official statistics show that on average, over the last ten (10) years, there have been about 1,200 occurring as a consequence of about 3,000 road accidents.

Unexpectedly, road accidents have become a serious public health hazard in the country because the loss of lives combines with numerous physical handicaps or emotional distresses. The above figures are a challenge the community of road users as well as the public authorities.

The former are mostly called upon to change their risky behaviour on the road, while the latter have the task of permanently reinventing public policies to address the complex and unending societal problem of road insecurity.

As far as the youth are concerned, whether they are educated or not, they are the most vulnerable. This is due to their ignorance or non-respect of basic road safety rules.

It is in this respect that the Ministry of Transport has been targeting this category of road users over the past years. The intention is to carry out specific sensitisation and capacity enhancement actions towards them, with the purpose of reducing the frequency and gravity of road accidents in our cities. It is in this purpose that the project for the Social Mobilisation for Road Safety in the Bamenda 1 Council Area, is being launched, not only to provide some Commercial Bike Riders with some basic training on road safety, but also to offer them a unique opportunity for access to information, initiative and exchanges on the topic.

II. OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

General objective

The project aims at reducing the frequency of accidents and the vulnerability of the people of Bamenda 1 Council Area to road accidents, and to gradually instigate a culture of road safety and responsible behavior among the population.

Specific objectives

The specific objectives of the project are:

- To sensitise the youths in the council about the major stakes in road safety;
 - To set up "Road safety clubs" within the most sensitive neighbourhoods;
