- 1.2 In this Tender File, the term "day" means a calendar day.

#### Article 2: Financing

The source of financing of the works forming the subject of this invitation to tender shall be specified in the Special Regulations.

Article 8: Content of Tender File......

### Article 3: Fraud and corruption

- **3.1** The Contracting Authority requires of bidders and contractors the strict respect of rules of professional ethics during the award and execution of public contracts. By virtue of this principle:
  - a) The following definitions shall be admitted:
    - Shall be guilty of "corruption" whoever offers, gives, requests or accepts any advantage in view of influencing the action of a public official during the award or execution of a contract;
    - II. Is involved in "fraudulent manoeuvres" whoever deforms or distorts facts in order to influence the award or execution of a contract;
    - III. "Collusive practices" shall mean any form of agreement between two or among several bidders (whether the Contracting Authority is aware or not) aimed at artificially maintaining the prices of bids at levels not corresponding to those resulting from competition;
    - IV. "Coercive practices" shall mean any form of harm against persons or their property or threats against them in order to influence their action during the award or execution of a contract.
    - b) Any proposed award shall be rejected if it is proved that the proposed preferred bidder is directly or through an intermediary, guilty of corruption or is involved in fraudulent manoeuvres, collusive or coercive practices for the award of this contract.
  - 3.2 The Minister Delegate at the Presidency in charge of public contracts may, as a precaution, take a decision of exclusion from bidding for a period not exceeding two (2) years against any bidder found guilty of influence peddling, of conflicts of interest, insider trading, fraud, corruption or production of non-genuine documents in the bid, without prejudice to criminal proceedings that may be brought against him

#### Article 4: Candidates allowed to compete

4.1 If the invitation to tender is restricted, consultation is addressed to all candidates retained after a pre-qualification procedure.

- 4.2 Generally, the invitation to tender is addressed to all entrepreneurs, subject to the following provisions:
  - (a) A bidder (including all members of a group of enterprises and all sub-contractors to the bidder) must be from an eligible country, in accordance with the funding agreement.
  - (b) A bidder (including all members of a group of enterprises and all sub-contractors to the bidder) must not be in a situation of conflict of interest, subject to disqualification. A bidder shall be judged to be in a situation of conflict of interest if he:
    - i) is or was associated in the past with an enterprise (or a subsidiary of this enterprise) which
      provided consultancy services for the conception, preparation of specifications and other
      documents used within the scope of contracts awarded for this invitation to tender; or
    - ti) Presents more than one bid within the context of invitation to tender, except authorised variants according to article 17, where need be; meanwhile, this does not prevent the participation of sub-contractors in more than one bid.
    - iii) The Contracting Authority or Project Owner has financial interests in the capital in a way as to compromise the transparency of the procedures of award of public contracts.
  - (c) The bidder must not have been excluded from bidding for public contracts.
  - (d) A Cameroonian public enterprise may participate in the consultation if it can demonstrate that it is (i) legally and financially autonomous, (ii) managed according to commercial laws and (iii) not under the direct supervisory authority of the Contracting Authority or Project Owner.

#### Article 5: Building materials, materials, supplies, equipment and authorised services

- 5.1 Building materials, the contractor's materials, supplies, equipment and services forming the subject of this contract must originate from countries meeting the criteria of origin defined in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender and all expenditure done within the context of the contract shall be limited to the said building materials, materials, supplies, equipment and services.
- 5.2 Within the meaning of this 5.1 above, the term "originate" shall designate the place where the goods are extracted, cultivated, produced, manufactured and from where the services originate.

#### Article 6: Qualification of bidder

- 6.1 As an integral part of their bid, bidders must:
  - (a) submit a power of attorney making the signatory of the bid bound by the bid; and
  - (b) Provide all information (complete or update information included in their request for prequalification which may have changed in the case where the candidates took part in prequalification) requested of bidders in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender, in order to establish their qualification to execute the contract.

Where necessary, bidders should provide information relating to the following points:

- (i) The production of certified balance sheets and recent turnovers;
- (ii) Access to a line of credit or availability of other financial resources;
- (iii) Orders acquired and contracts awarded;
- (iv) Pending litigations; and
- (v) Availability of indispensable equipment.

- Bids presented by two or more associated undertakings (joint-contracting) must satisfy the following conditions:
- (a) The bid must include all the information listed in article 6(1) above. The Special Regulations must indicate the information to be furnished by the group and that to be furnished by each member of the group;
- (b) The bid and the contract must be signed in a way that is binding on all members of the group;
- (c) The nature of the group (joint or several) must be specified in the Special Regulations and justified with the production of a joint venture agreement in due form;
- (d) The member of the group designated as the representative will represent all the undertakings vis à vis the Project Owner and Contracting Authority with regard to the execution of the Contract;
- (e) In case of joint co-contracting, the co-contractors shall share the sums which are paid by the Project Owner into a single account. On the other hand, each undertaking is paid into its own account by the Project Owner where it is joint co-contracting.
- 6.3 Bidders must equally present sufficiently detailed proposals to demonstrate that they comply with the technical specifications and execution time-limits set in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender.
- 6.4 Bidders requesting to benefit from the margin of preference must furnish all the necessary information to prove that they satisfy the eligibility criteria set in article 33 of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender. to brown to company of the propagators tenders and a suppression of the invitation to tender.

### Article 7: Visit of works site and public dram bidding for public costs of works are bidden and (c)

- 7.1 The bidder is advised to visit and inspect the site and its environs and obtain by himself and under his own responsibility, all the information which may be necessary for the preparation of the bid and the execution of the works. The related cost of the visit of the site shall be borne by the bidder.
- 7.2 The Project Owner shall authorise the bidder and his employees or agents to enter the premises and the land for the said visit but only on the express condition that the bidder, his employees and agents free the Project Owner, his employees and agents of any responsibility that may ensue and indemnify them if necessary and that they shall remain responsible for any deadly or corporal accident, loss or material damages, costs and fees incurred from this visit.
- 7.3 The Project Owner may organise a visit of the site of the works during the preparatory meeting to establishing the bids mentioned in article 19 of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender.

Document No. 12. Justifications of preliminary studies; to be filled by the Project Owner or Delegated Project Owner;

Document No. 13. List of first grade banking establishments or financial institutions approved by the Minister in charge of Finance authorised to issue bonds for public contracts to be inserted by the Contracting Authority.

8.2 The bidder must examine all the regulations, forms, conditions and specifications contained in the Tender File. It is up to him to furnish all the information requested and prepare a bid in compliance with all aspects of the said file.

#### Article 9: Clarifications on the Tender File and complaints

9.1 Any bidder who wants to obtain clarifications on the Tender File may request them from the Contracting Authority in writing or by electronic mail (fax or e-mail) at the Contracting Authority's address indicated in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender and send a copy to the Project Owner. The Contracting Authority replies in writing to any request for clarification received at least fourteen (14) days prior to the deadline for the submission of bids.

A copy of the Contracting Authority's response, indicating the question posed but not mentioning the

author, is addressed to all bidders who bought the Tender File.

- 9.2 Between the publication of the tender notice including the pre-qualification phase of candidates and the opening of bids, any bidder who feels aggrieved in the public contracts award procedure may lodge a complaint to the Minister in charge of Public Contracts.
- 9.3 A copy of the complaint should be addressed to the Contracting Authority and to the body in charge of the regulation of public contracts and the chairperson of the Tenders Board.
- 9.4 The Contracting Authority has five (5) days to react. A copy of the reaction shall be forwarded to MINMAP and the body in charge of the regulation of public contracts.

#### Article 10: Amendment of the Tender File

- 10.1 The Contracting Authority may at any moment, prior to the deadline for the submission of bids and for any reason, be it at his initiative or in reply to a request for clarification formulated by a bidder, amend the Tender File by publishing an addendum.
- 10.2 Any published addendum shall be an integral part of the Tender File, in accordance with article 8.1 of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender and must be communicated in writing or made known by a traceable means to all bidders who bought the Tender File.
- 10.3 In order to give bidders sufficient time to take account of the addendum in the preparation of their bids, the Contracting Authority may postpone as is necessary, the deadline for the submission of bids, in accordance with provisions of article 22 of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender

#### C Preparation of bids

#### Article 11: Tender costs

The candidate shall bear the costs related to the preparation and presentation of his bid and the Contracting Authority and the Project Owner shall in no case be responsible for these costs nor pay for them whatever the evolution or outcome of the invitation to tender procedure.

#### Article 12: Language of bid

The bid as well as any correspondence and any document exchanged between the bidder and the Contracting Authority shall be written in English or French. Complementary documents and the forms provided by the bidder may be written in another language on condition that a precise translation into either English or French of the passages concerning the bid is included; in which case for reasons of interpretation, the translation shall be considered to be authentic.

#### Article 13: Constituent documents of the offer

13.1 The offer presented by the bidder shall include the documents detailed in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender, duly filled and put together in three volumes:

- IV. The CCAP is duly initialed on each page and signed on the last page.
- V. Localization plan is duly signed by the authority concern.

The candidate shall bear the costs related to the preparation and presentation of his bisebulant

- I. The submission letter, in original drafted according to the model attached, stamped at the rate in force, signed and dated;
- II. The unit price schedule duly completed, with an indication of the unit price excluding VAT in letters and figures;
  - III. Detail Bill of Quantities and cost estimate of the work completed;
  - IV. Sub-details of the different prices according to the model attached;

In this regard, the bidders will use the documents and models provided in the Tender File, subject to the provisions of article 17(1) of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender concerning the other possible forms of guarantees.

13.2 If in accordance with the provisions of the Special Regulations of Invitation to Tender, the bidders present offers for several lots of the same invitation to tender, they could indicate rebates offered in case of award of more than one lot.

#### Article 14: Bid price

- 14.1 Except otherwise stated in the Tender File, the amount of the contract shall cover all the works described in article 1.1 of the General Regulations of the invitation to tender, on the basis of the price schedule and the detailed bill of quantities and estimates presented by the bidder.
- 14.2 The bidder shall fill the unit prices and totals of all items on the schedule and bill of quantities and estimates.
- 14.3 Subject to contrary provisions provided for in the Special Regulations and in the Special Administrative Conditions, all dues, taxes and fees payable by the bidder on grounds of the contract or on any other ground, thirty (30) days prior to the submission of the bids, shall be included in the prices and in the total amount of the bid presented by the bidder.
- 14.4 If a price revision/updating clause is provided for in the contract, the date of establishment of the initial price, as well as the price revision/updating conditions for the said price must be specified. This is with the understanding that any contract of duration less than one (1) year shall not be subject to price revision.
- 14.5 All unit prices must be justified by sub-details established in accordance with the structure proposed in document 8 of the Tender File.

#### Article 15: Currency of bid and payment

- 15.1 In case of international invitations to tender, the currencies of the bid shall follow the provisions of either Option A or Option B below, the applicable option being that retained in the Special Regulations of the invitation to tender.
- **15.2 Option A:** The amount of the bid shall be entirely made in the national currency. The amount of the bid, unit prices of the price schedule and the prices of the bill of quantities and estimates are completely made in CFA francs in the following manner:
  - a) Prices shall be entirely drawn in the national currency. The bidder who intends to commit expenditures in other currencies for the execution of the works shall indicate in the annex to the bid the percentage(s) of the amount of the bid necessary to cover the needs in foreign currencies, without exceeding the maximum of the three currencies of member countries of the funding institution of the contract.
  - b) The exchange rates used by the bidder to convert his bid into the national currency shall be specified by the bidder in an annex to the bid in compliance with the specifications of the Special Regulations. - 15.4 The Contracting Authority may request the bidders to explain the needs in national and foreign currencies and to justify that the amounts included in the unit and total prices and indicated in annex to the bids are reasonable; to this end, a detailed statement of their needs in foreign currencies shall be furnished by the bidder.
- 15.5 During the execution of the works, most of the foreign currency to be paid as part of contract may be revised by mutual agreement between the Contracting Authority and the entrepreneur in a way as take account of any modification in the foreign currency needs within the context of the contract.

- 16.1 Bids must remain valid during the period stated in the Special Regulations from the date of submission of the bids fixed by the Contracting Authority, in application of article 22 of the Special Regulations. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Contracting Authority or Delegated Contracting Authority as not being in compliance.
- 16.2 Under exceptional circumstances, the Contracting Authority may seek the approval of bidders to extend the validity time-limit. The request and the responses that will be given shall be in writing (or by fax). The validity of the bid bond provided for in article 17 of the General Regulations shall equally be extended for a corresponding duration. A bidder may refuse to extend the validity of his bid without losing his bid bond. A bidder who consents to an extension shall not be asked to modify his bid nor shall he be authorised to do so.

#### Article 17: Bid bond

17.1 In application of article 13 of the General Regulations, the bidder shall furnish a bid bond of the amount specified in the Special Regulations and which bid bond shall be a full part of his bid.

- 17.2 The bid bond must conform to the model presented in the Tender File; other models may be authorised subject to the prior approval of the Contracting Authority. The bid bond will remain valid for thirty (30) days beyond the original date set for the validity of bids or any other validity time-limit requested by the Contracting Authority and accepted by the bidder, in accordance with the provisions of article 16 (2) of the General Regulations.
- 17.3 Any bid without an acceptable bid bond shall be rejected by the Tenders Board as not in conformity.

- 17.4 The bid bonds of bidders who are not retained shall be returned within fifteen (15) days after publication of the award result.

- 17.6 The bid bond may be seized:
  - (a) if the bidder withdraws his bid during the period of validity;

#### Article 18: Varying proposals of bidders

- 18.1 Where the works can be executed within variable deadlines, the Special Regulations shall specify these deadlines and shall indicate the method retained for the evaluation of the completion deadline proposed by the bidder within the specified deadlines. Bids that propose deadlines beyond those specified shall be considered as not being in conformity.
- 18.2 Except in the case mentioned in article 18(3) below, bidders wishing to offer technical variants must first assess the basic solution of the Contracting Authority as described in the Tender File and furnish in addition all the information which the Contracting Authority needs for a complete evaluation of the proposed variant, including the plans, calculations, technical specifications, sub-details of prices and proposed construction methods and all other useful information. If necessary, the Contracting Authority will examine only the technical variants of the bidder whose bid is in compliance with the basic solution has been evaluated as the lowest bid.
- 18.3 When according to the Special Regulations the bidders are authorised to directly submit the technical variants for certain parts of the works, these parts of the works must be described in the technical specifications. Such variants shall be evaluated on their own merit in accordance with the provisions of article 31(2) (g) of the General Regulations.

#### Article 19: Preparatory meeting to the establishment of bids

- 19.1 Except otherwise stipulated in the Special Regulations, a bidder may be invited to take part in a preparatory meeting which will hold at the date and place indicated in the Special Regulations.
- 19.2 The subject of the preparatory meeting shall be to furnish clarifications and answer any questions which may be raised at this stage.
- 19.3 As much as possible, the bidder is requested to submit any question in a way as to reach the Contracting Authority at least one week before the meeting The Contracting Authority may not reply to questions received too late. In this case, the questions and answers shall be transmitted according to the methods set in article 19(4) below.
- The minutes of the meeting, including the text of the questions asked and the replies given, including questions prepared after the meeting, shall be forwarded immediately to everyone who bought the Tender File. Any modification of documents of the Tender File listed in article 8 of the General Regulations which may prove to be necessary at the end of the preparatory meeting shall be done by the Contracting Authority by publishing an addendum in accordance with the provisions of article 10 of the General Regulations and not through the minutes of the preparatory meeting.
- 19.5 The fact that a bidder does not attend a preparatory meeting for the establishment of bids shall not be a reason for disqualification.

- b) By excluding projected sums and where necessary provisions for unforeseen occurrences featuring in the bill of quantities and estimates but by adding the amount of works done under State supervision where they are cost in a competitive manner as specified in the Special Regulations.

- d) By appropriately adjusting any other modification, divergence or quantifiable reservation on technical or financial basis.
- e)By taking into consideration the various execution time-limits proposed by the bidders, if they are authorised by the Special Regulations;
- f) If need be, in accordance with the provisions of article 13(2) of the General Regulations and the Special Regulations by applying the rebates offered by the bidder for the award of more than one lot, if this invitation to tender is launched simultaneously for several lots.
- g) If need be, in accordance with the provisions of article 18(3) of the Special Regulations and the Technical Specifications, the proposed technical variants, if they are permitted, shall be evaluated on their own merit and independently of the fact that the bidder offered or not a price for the technical solution specified by the Contracting Authority in the Special Regulations.
- 32.3 The estimated effect of price revision formulae featuring in the GAC and SAC applied during the period of execution of the contract shall not be considered during the evaluation of bids.
- 32.4 If the bid judged the lowest bid is considered abnormally low or strongly unbalanced in relation to the estimates of the Project Owner for the works to be executed in this contract, the Tenders Board may, from the sub-details of prices furnished by the bidder for any element or all the elements of the bill of quantities and estimates, verify if these prices are compatible with the construction methods and proposed calendar. In the case where the justifications presented by the bidder are not satisfactory, the Contracting Authority may reject the bid after the technical opinion of the Public Contracts Regulatory Agency.

#### Article 33: Preference granted national bidders and include to notificate and the (d)

National contractors shall benefit from a margin of national preference during the evaluation of bids as provided for in the Public Contracts Code.

#### Article 34: Award

- 34.1 The Contracting Authority shall award the contract to the bidder whose bid was judged essentially in compliance with the Tender File and who has the required technical and financial capacities to execute the contract satisfactorily and whose bid was evaluated as the lowest by including, where necessary, proposed rebates
- If, according to article 13(2) of the General Regulations, the invitation to tender comprises several lots, the lowest bid shall be determined by evaluating this contract with other lots to be awarded concurrently, by taking into account the rebates offered by the bidders in the case of more than one lot.
- Any award of contract shall be made to the bidder fulfilling the technical and financial capacities required resulting from the evaluation criteria and presenting the bid evaluated as the lowest.

# Article 35: The right by the Contracting Authority to declare an invitation to tender unsuccessful or cancel a procedure i bid and dairly ni acoust of its abundance and because abid to eating

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to cancel a procedure of invitation to tender after the authorisation of the Minister Delegate at the Presidency in charge of Public Contracts where the bids have been opened or to declare an invitation to tender unsuccessful after the advice of the competent Tenders Board, without any claims being entertained.

#### Article 36: Notification of award of the contract

Before the expiry of the validity of the bids set in the Special Regulations, the Contracting Authority shall notify the preferred bidder by telecopy confirmed by registered mail or by any other means that his bid was retained. This letter will indicate the amount the Project Owner will pay the contractor to execute the works and the execution time-limit.

#### Article 37: Publication of results of award and petitions

- 37.1 The Contracting Authority shall communicate to any bidder or administration concerned, upon request addressed to it within a maximum deadline of five (5) days after publication of the award results, the Independent Observer's report as well as the minutes of the award session of the related contract to which shall be attached the evaluation report of the bids.
- 37.2 The Contracting Authority is bound to communicate the reasons for the rejection of bids of the bidders concerned who so request.
- 37.3 After publication of the award results, bids that are not withdrawn within fifteen (15) days shall be destroyed, without any claims for compensation being entertained. Only the copy destined for the body in charge of regulation shall be kept.
- 37.4 In case of petition, it should be addressed to the Public Contracts Authority, with copies to the body in charge of the regulation of public contracts, the Contracting Authority and the chairperson of the Tenders Board concerned.

### **ARTICLE 6: GENERAL APPLICABLE TEXTS**

This contract shall be governed by the following general instruments [to be adapted according to the case]:

### Article 7: COMMUNICATION

- 7.1 All notifications and written communication within the framework of this jobbing order shall be sent to the following address:
  - a) In the case where the contractor is the addressee: beyond the time-limit of 15 days fixed in Article 6 (1) of the GAC to make his domicile known to the Chief of Service and immediately after completion of the works, correspondences shall be validly address to Nkor Council.
  - b) In the case where the Project Owner is the addressee:
    Sir/Madam\_\_\_\_\_ [to be specified] with a copy addressed to the Contracting Authority,
    Contract Manager, Contract Engineer, Project Manager and where need be, within the same
    deadline

- c) In the case where the Contracting Authority is the addressee: The Divisional Delegate of Public Contracts for Bui with copies addressed to the Chief of Service and the Engineer.
- 7.2 The contractor shall address all written notifications or correspondences to the Engineer with a copy to the Chief of Service.

### **ARTICLE 8: ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS**

The various Administrative Orders shall be established and notified as follows:

The Administrative Order to start execution of works shall be signed by the Contracting Authority and notified to the contractor by the Project Owner with a copy to the Contracting Authority, the Contract Manager, Contract Engineer, the Paying Body and the Project Manager, where applicable.

Upon proposal by the Project Owner, Administrative Orders with an incidence on the objective, the amount and execution deadline shall be signed by Contracting Authority and notified by the Project Owner to the Contractor with a copy to the Contracting Authority, the Contract Manager, the Control Engineer, the Project Manager and the Paying Body. The prior endorsement of the Paying Body shall possibly be required before the signature of those that have an incidence on the amount.

- 8.1 Administrative Orders of a technical nature linked to the normal progress of the work and without financial incidence shall be signed directly by Contract Manager and notified to the contractor by the Control Engineer or Project Manager (where applicable) with a copy to the Contracting Authority and Contract Manager.
- 8.2 Administrative Orders serving as warnings shall be signed by the Project Owner and notified to the contractor by the Contract Manager with a copy to the Contracting Authority, the Contract Engineer and Project Manager.
- 8.3 Administrative Orders for suspension or resumption of work as a result of the weather or any other case of force majeure shall be signed by the Contracting Authority and notified by his services to the contractor with a copy to the Project Owner, Contract Manager, Contract Engineer and Project Manager.
- 8.4 Administrative Orders prescribing works necessary to remedy disorders which could appear on structures during the guarantee period and not related to normal usage shall be signed by the Contract Manager upon the proposal of the Contract Engineer and notified to the contractor by the Control Engineer.
- 8.5 The contractor has a time-limit of fifteen (15) days to issue reservations on any Administrative Order received. Having reservations shall not free the enterprise of executing the Administrative Orders received.
- 8.6 Concerning Administrative Order signed by the Contracting Authority and notified by the Project Owner, the notification must be done within a maximum of 30 days from the date of transmission by the Contracting Authority to the Project Manager. Beyond this deadline, the Contracting Authority shall establish the default of the Project Owner, take over from him and carry out the said notification.

### ARTICLE 9: CONTRACTS WITH CONDITIONAL PHASES (ARTICLE 9 OF GAC)

At the end of a phase, the Project Owner shall carry out the acceptance of the works and issue an attestation of proper execution to the contractor. This attestation shall condition the start of the following conditional phase.

### ARTICLE 10: CONTRACTOR'S EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL (Article 15 of GAC supplemented)

### **CHAPTER 2: FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**

### ARTICLE 11 GUARANTEES AND BONDS (Articles 29 and 41 of GAC)

### 11.1 Final bond

The final bond shall be set at 2 % of the amount of the contract, inclusive of all taxes.

It is constituted and transmitted to the Contracting Authority within a maximum deadline of twenty (20) days of the notification of the contract.

The bond shall be returned or the guarantee released within one month following the date of provisional acceptance of the works, following a release issued by the Contracting Authority upon request by the contractor.

### 11.2 Performance bond (Guarantee Retention)

The retention fund shall be set at 10 % of the amount of the contract, inclusive of all taxes.

The return or release of the retention fund or security shall be done within one month after final acceptance by release issued by the Contracting Authority upon request by the contractor.

### 11.3 Guarantee of start-off advance

The contractor may be granted a start-off amount of 20% of the contract amount (inclusive of taxes) upon request.

The start-off payment shall be guaranteed at 100% by a Cameroonian bank recognized by the Ministry in charge of Finance.

The work done shall be evaluated using the unit price.

### ARTICLE 16: ADVANCES (article 28 of the GAC)

- 16.1 The Contracting Authority may grant a start-off advance equal to 20% of the amount of the contract].
- 16.2 This advance whose value cannot exceed twenty (20) percent of the initial amount inclusive of all taxes shall be guaranteed at one hundred (100) percent by a banking establishment governed by Cameroon law or a first-rate financial institution in accordance with the instruments in force and reimbursed by deduction of the payments on accounts to be paid to the contractor during the execution of the contract according to the modalities laid down in the Special Administrative Conditions.
- 16.3 The total amount of the advance must be reimbursed not later than when the value in basic price of the works reaches eighty (80) percent of the amount of the contract.
- 16.4 As the reimbursement advances, the Project Owner shall issue the release of the corresponding part of the guarantee upon the express request by the contractor.
- 16.5 The possibility of granting start-off advance or advance for supplies must be expressly stipulated in the Tender File.

### Article 17: PAYMENT FOR WORKS (articles 26, 27 and 30 of the GAC supplemented)

### 17.1 Establishment of works executed

Before the 30<sup>th</sup> of each month, the contractor and the Project Manager shall jointly establish a job cost sheet which summarises and fixes the quantities executed and established for each item on the schedule during the month and capable of giving entitlement to payment.

### 17.2 Monthly detailed account

No later than the fifth  $(5^{th})$  of the month following the month of the services, the contractor shall hand over to the Project Manager two draft provisional monthly detailed accounts in seven copies (one detailed account exclusive of VAT and the other inclusive of taxes), according to the agreed model and establishing the total amount of the sums to which he may lay claim as a result of the execution of the contract since the start of the contract.

Only the detailed account exclusive of VAT shall be paid to the contractor. The detailed account of the amount of the taxes shall be the subject of an entry into the budgets of the Ministry in charge of Finance

Only the amount exclusive of VAT shall be paid to the contractor as follows:

- 1.1 % paid to the public treasury as AIR due by the contractor.

The Project Manager has a time-limit of seven (7) days to forward to the Contract Manager the detailed accounts he has approved.

The Contract Engineer has a maximum time-limit of twenty-one (21) days to forward the detailed accounts he approved such that they are in his possession not later than the twelfth of the month.

The Contract Manager has a deadline of fourteen (14) days maximum to sign the detailed accounts.

### ARTICLE 18: INTEREST ON OVERDUE PAYMENTS (Article 31 of the GAC)

Possible interests on overdue payments are paid by statement of sums due in accordance with article 88 of Decree No. 2004/275 of 24 September 2004 to institute the Public Contracts Code.

#### **ARTICLE 19: PENALTIES FOR DELAY**

- A. Penalties for lateness.
- 19.1 The amount set for penalties for delays is set as follows:
  - a) One two thousandth (1/2000th) of the initial jobbing order amount all taxes inclusive per calendar day of delay from the first (1st) to the thirtieth (30th) day beyond the contractual time-limit.
  - b) One One thousandth (1/1000th) of the initial amount of the jobbing order inclusive of all taxes per calendar day beyond the 30th day.
- 19.2 The cumulated amount of penalties for delay shall be limited to ten percent (10%) of the initial jobbing order inclusive of all taxes.

### ARTICLE 20: FINAL DETAILED ACCOUNT (article 34 of the GAC)

The signing of the general and final detailed account without reservation by the contract or definitely binds the two parties puts an end to the contract, except with regard to interest on overdue payments.

21.2 The contractor has up to thirty (30) days to return the signed final detailed account.

### ARTICLE 22: TAX AND CUSTOMS SCHEDULE TO THE STATE OF STREET OF STREET

Decree No. 2003/651 of 16 April 2003 to lay down the conditions for implementing the tax regulations and customs procedures applicable to public contracts. The taxes applicable to this contract include notably:

- Taxes and dues relating to industrial and commercial projects, including the AIR which is a

### ARTICLE 25: ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PROJECT OWNER (GAC supplemented)

- 25.1 The Project Owner shall be bound to furnish the contractor with information necessary for the execution of his mission and to guarantee, at the cost of the contractor, access to sites of projects.
- 25.2 The Project Owner shall ensure the contractor of protection against threats, insults, violence, assault and battery, slander or defamation of which he could be victim by reason of or during the exercise of his mission.

### ARTICLE 26: EXECUTION TIME-LIMIT OF THE CONTRACT (article 38 of the GAC)

26.1 The time-limit for the execution of the works forming the subject of this contract shall be one hundred and twenty (120) days.

26.2 This time-limit shall run from the date of notification of the Administrative Order to commence execution of the works.

### ARTICLE 27: ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR

The contractor shall be responsible for the works for which he has been chosen. To this effect, his mission shall be to ensure its execution under the supervision of the Engineer in conformity with the regulation and standards in force and in respect to the work schedule. The contractor shall also be expected to carry out all the necessary calculations, chose and buy all machines, adequate materials etc. required for the work and engage suitable workers.

The contractor confirms that he has verified the volume of work to be executed and that he is reputed to have taken perfect cognizance of the scope of the works and the necessity for prompt action to request irrespective of whether he has to use his own equipment or hire equipment to execute the work. To this end, he cannot use any omission or under estimation of the works to make any claims of any nature whatsoever.

Removal of equipment, materials, installations and work site waste shall be carried out by the contractor before reception, failing which the Contracting Authority shall automatically proceed with it soon after the expiry date, at the contractor's expense.

### ARTICLE 28: PROVISION OF DOCUMENTS AND SITE (article 42 of the GAC)

A reproducible copy of the plans featuring in the Tender File shall be submitted by the Contract Manager.

The Project Owner shall make available the site and access ways to the contractor at the appropriate time as the works progress.

### ARTICLE 29: INSURANCE OF STRUCTURES AND CIVIL LIABILITIES (article 45 of GAC)

The following insurance policies are required within the scope of this contract in the minimum amounts indicated hereafter within fifteen (15) days of the notification of the contract (to be adapted):

- Liability insurance, business manager;
- Comprehensive insurance of the site;
- Insurance covering its ten-year obligation, where applicable.

### ARTICLE 30: DOCUMENTS TO BE FURNISHED BY THE CONTRACTOR (Article 49 of the GAC supplemented)

### 30.1 Programme of works, Quality Assurance Plan and others (to be specified).

a) Within a minimum deadline of [Fifteen (15) days] from the date of notification of the Administrative Order to commence execution, the contractor shall submit in [six (6)] copies for the approval of [Contract Manager after the endorsement of the Project Manager (or Project Engineer] the execution programme of the works, his supply calendar, his draft Quality Assurance Plan and the Environment Management Plan, where applicable.

This programme shall be exclusively presented according to the furnished models.

Two (2) copies of these documents will be returned to him within a deadline of fifteen (15) days from the date of reception with:

- Either the indication "GOOD FOR EXECUTION";

- Or the indication of their rejection including the reasons for the said rejection.

The contractor has eight (8) days to present a new draft. The Contract Manager or the Project Manager then has a deadline of five (5) days to give his approval or possibly make comments. Delay in approving the draft execution schedule shall stay the execution deadline.

The approval given by the Contract Manager or Project Manager does not in any way release the contractor of his responsibilities. Meanwhile, works executed before the approval of the programme shall neither be ascertained nor paid for. The updated and approved schedule will become the contractual schedule.

The contractor shall constantly update on site, a schedule that will take account of real progress of the site. Significant modifications may only be made on the contractual programme upon receiving the approval of the Project Manager. After approval of the execution schedule by the Contract Manager, the latter shall transmit it within five (5) days to the Contracting Authority without staying its execution. However, if important modifications alter the objective of the contract or the nature of the works, the Contracting Authority shall return the execution schedule accompanied by reservations to be lifted within fifteen (15) days of the date of reception.

- b) The Environment Management Plan should bring out notably the choice technical conditions of the site and basic life, conditions of the backfill of the extraction sites and conditions for reinstating the works and installation sites.
- c) The contractor shall indicate in this schedule the equipment and methods which he intends to use as well as the personnel he intends to employ.
- d) The approval granted by the Contract Manager or Project Manager shall in no way diminish the responsibility of the contractor with regard to the harmful consequences which their implementation may cause both towards third parties and the respect of clauses of the contract.

### 30.2 Execution draft

- Present the site log-book to the contractor;
- Establish and sign an on-the-spot report (minutes). All the members at the site are expected to sign
  this report with or without stamps and the absence of any member should be indicated in the
  report and his signatory left out.

### **ARTICLE 33: SUB-CONTRACTING**

This jobbing order may give rise to sub-contracts or subsidiary orders with a maximum accord of 30% of the initial jobbing order amount.

However, any recourse to sub-contractors or placing of subsidiary orders shall be subject to the prior authorization of the Contracting Authority. Notwithstanding the recourse to sub-contracting or placing of subsidiary orders, the contracting partner shall be responsible for the execution of all the obligation of the said jobbing order.

### **ARTICLE 34: WORKS SITE JOURNAL (LOG BOOKS)**

- 34.1 The worksite journal shall be systematically jointly signed by the Engineer and the Contractor's representative each site visit.
- 34.2 It is a joint document in a single copy. Its pages shall be numbered and initialed. No page should be removed. The erased or cancelled parts shall be mentioned on the margin for validation.

### Article 35: Use of explosives (article 60 of the GAC)

Subject to restrictions or prohibitions possibly stipulated in the SAC, the contractor must take under his responsibility, all the necessary precautions so that the use of explosives is not dangerous to the personnel and third parties and does not cause damage to neighbouring property and structures as well as to the structure forming the subject of the contracting.

- 37.1 The contractor shall furnish within **one** (1) **month** after completion of the works three (3) copies of all working documents and drawings as executed, especially those relevant to the maintenance of the works.
- 37.2 A penalty of 30% of the guarantee retention shall be retained in the event where the contractor fails to comply with Article 34.1 above.

### 34.2 It is a joint document in a single copy. Its pages shall be CTIMIL AMIT BATHARAUB : 88 BATHARAUB : 38.2

The guarantee period shall be **one** (1) **year** to run from the date of the provisional reception of the works or can be guaranteed by a caution of 100%.

### **ARTICLE 39: FINAL ACCEPTANCE**

Final reception shall take place within a maximum deadline of fifteen (15) days from the date of expiry of the guarantee period in case of no guarantee.

The procedure for final reception shall be the same as for provisional reception.

### CHAPTER V: MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

### ARTICLE 40: TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT (article 74 of the GAC)

The jobbing order may be terminated as provided for in Part III Paragraph 2 of Decree No. 2004/275 of 24 September 2004 instituting the Public Contracts Code and equally under the conditions laid down in Articles 74, 75 and 76 of the GAC especially in case of:

- Delay of more than fifteen (15) days in the execution of a Service Order or unjustified stoppage
  of more than seven (7) calendar days;
- Delay in work resulting in penalties of more than 10% of the amount of the works;

- Refusal to repeat poorly executed works;
- Default by the contractor;
- Persistent on payment for services.

### ARTICLE 41: FORCE MAJEURE (Unforeseen Circumstances)

If the contractor were to raise the issue of force majeure, the thresholds below which claims shall not be admitted are:

- Rainfall: 200 millimetres in 24 hours;
- Wind: 40 metres per second;
- Flood: decennial flood frequency.

### ARTICLE 42: DISAGREEMENTS AND DISPUTES (article 79 of the GAC)

Disagreements and disputes resulting from the execution of this contract may be settled amicably.

Where no amicable solution can be found for a disagreement, it is brought before the competent court in Bui Division of the Republic of Cameroon

Any dispute arising from this jobbing order shall be resolved amicably. Failure to arrive at a compromise, the matter shall be referred to the competent court in Bui Division of the Republic of Cameroon.

### 1 - GENERALITIES

This present special technical specifications concern THE CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPPING OF A BLOCK OF TWO CLASSROOMS AT GS NCHINI, NONI SUB DIVISION.BUI DIVISION.NORTH WEST REGION

. It is the duty of the contractor to realize the structure as per the execution plans that shall be approved by the competent authority and sample models of equipments and furniture provided by the project owner.

Through the Project Engineer, the contractor shall furnish the owner of the project and other project team members within the shortest possible time with an installation plan showing clearly how he intends to run the work site. A fence in local materials shall enclose the whole work site to avoid trespassing.

### SIGN - POSTS

The contractor shall put in place at his expense sign-posts indicating work in conformity with the plans put at his disposal by the authority that signed the contract.

### Site hut

The contractor shall construct a temporal site office with a site store and a mess room for the workers. In case there a rented premises, he must prove with a tenancy agreement.

Hygiene and safety

The contractor shall ensure total hygiene and security of the site by constructing a temporal pit latrine and putting up a temporal fence around the project site if that be the case.

The contractor shall be responsible for the protection of the structures before final reception. He shall be equally responsible for all tools and materials present at the work site. He shall seek an insurance policy to cover theft and fire incidence.

The contractor shall take all preventive measures against accidents. The owner of the project reserves the right to intervene in case of any emergency without necessary interfering with the responsibilities of the contractor.

The contractor shall verify all dimensions on the plans. For execution no dimension shall be measured with a scale rule from the plans. The contractor shall check in-situ the possibility of translating the dimensions on plans to the structure before work begins. He shall refer to the Project Engineer in case of any doubt. He shall not on his own modify anything on the structure and shall inform the Project Engineer of any changes that he considers necessary.

All modifications accepted by the contractor shall be accomplished in a specified duration and at his cost without modification of the contract amount. The owner of the project shall have the right to the final choice in case of any modification.

### 2 - PREPARATORY WORKS - SETTING OUT OF THE OFFICE O

These works concern the clearing of the site and evacuation of the rubbles to the public discharge, the clearing and levelling of the site where necessary.

The setting out will be in respect to the technical plans. The setting out profile boards will be at least 1, 20 m from the outside axes, this to facilitate trenching and other earthworks, and good circulation. The commencement of excavation will be accepted by the control engineer without checking the conformity of the setting.

The minimal depth of the excavation trenches shall be of 80cm, and depending on the soil bearing capacity. Where there is black cotton soil or soil with low bearing capacity at the bottom of the trench, the contractor shall continue excavation up to a depth as will be approved by the control engineer. The excavations will be done manually and no concrete or mortar shall be laid on the bottom of the trench without the acceptance of the trench bottom of excavation by the control engineer.

The descri Descriptive notice completes or confirms the indications on the execution plans. In the case of contradictions between the plans and the descriptive notice, the project team shall be contacted for examination, elaboration and conclusion.

These technical specifications have as objective the definition of the consistence of works to be executed in accordance with the plans and according to technical norms for the construction of classroom buildings.

### 3 - FOUNDATION

Any blinding concrete will be of thickness 5cm dozed at 150 kg/m3 of firm consistence and will be laid on the bottom of the excavations where necessary. On it will be laid the footings of the ground half pillars until the level of the finished foundation. The foundation peripheral walls will be of masonry stones laid on cement mortar and finished with a DPC layer or ground beams of 20 x 20cm in reinforced concrete at a dosage of 350 kg/m³

The foundation will be filled with earth of good quality in successive compacted layers of 20cm where the fill depth exceeds 30cm. An over-site concrete of thickness 8cm will be laid to cover the whole foundation area at a dosage of 250 kg/m³ over a layer of stone hardcore (crushed sizes between 25-40mm).

The floor will be finished in cement sand screed of 3cm thick and coated to finish with cement paste trowel to finish.

cement for blocks of 15x20x40 cm and 38 for blocks of 10x20x40cm. They should be kept dry for at least 14days before lying on the elevation walls. The reinforced concrete pillars of section 15x15 and 15x30 at 350 kg/m3 will be cast as one raises the agglomerated hollow blocks walls and this is to permit a good adhesion. The characteristic strength of concrete at 28 days should not be less than 16Mpa. The maximal spacing of the pillars is to be 5, 00 m of span. The lintels 15 x 20 in reinforced concrete at 350 kg/m³ will be levelled to + 2,20m above the level of the finished foundation.

The average height under the ceiling is about 3,00m.

A chaining beam of 15 x 20cm in reinforced concrete at 350 kg/m3 will be laid above the finished level of the agglomerated hollow blocks walls with fixing plates so as to receive the wooden roof truss.

### - ROOF TRUSS AND THE COVERING:

- Trusses of treated and seasoned hardwood agreed by the Project Engineer shall compose of single frame rafters of 5cmx15cmx4m and spaced at 1.50m interval. These rafters will be solidly attached to the wall plate with the help of standby beam iron rods also spaced at 1.50m spacing;
  - i.e.: eucalyptus, mahogany, iroko etc.,
- Purlins and noggins- shall consist of 5x8cmx4m timbers. All structural timber shall be treated with carbonyl. The timber for the roof work will be of good quality, with the straight grain and free of any defect.
- -Roofing sheets: shall be in high rib (Tôle BAC) aluminum sheets of type 5/10mm. The sheets shall be fixed onto the purlins using screw nails equipped with aluminum gaskets and bituminous rubbers caps.
- -Facial board shall be 30cm wide and of high rib aluminum sheets (tôle bac) of 0.35mm thickness including lining.
- -Ceiling- will be made of 4mm thick (red plywood on both sides). fastened noggins of 4cm thick or 5x8 and treated with carbonyl. The spaces for ceiling joist panel will be 60x120cm in size. Eaves shall be equipped with wire mesh ventilation holes and a trap door will be provided in each of the classrooms. For external ceiling tôle lisse shall be used at the eaves including battens.

### 6 - ALUMINIUM AND METAL WORKS

### **Doors and Windows:**

- All doors will be made of forged iron double metal fitted on metallic frame anchored to the wall with angle bar 35mm. (1,00X2,20)m
- -All windows shutters shall be Aluminum sliding windows of (2,10 X 0,90) m.
- Window protectors shall be aluminum tube of (2,10 X 0,90) m.

Note: The window sill shall be at 1,70m and the design shall be provided on the plans.

### 7 - PLUMBING - SANITARY

If there be any sanitary fitting works, it will be executed according to plumbing norms. The dimensions and constructive dispositions will be made by the engineer.

agglomerated hollow blocks walls are being raised. Any necessary branching from AES/SONEL network should respect the regulation in force. Accessories and luminous elements (sockets, switches etc...) will be of good model. The set of facilities will be joined to a general earth hold.

The wall rendering (thickness at least 2,5 cm) will be of cement mortar at 400 kg/m<sup>3</sup>. There will be an under-coat layer and a finish layer floated and foamed to finish. They must be well cut horizontally and vertically using a **straight edge**. The external walls shall receive a coat of spata dash before plastering is done.

### 20cm in reinforced concrete at 350 kg/m3 will be DAITHIAY - 01

A layer of impression of quicklime will be applied previously on internal walls as preparatory layer. The interior walls and the ceiling will be painted in pantex 800. The external walls will be painted with a water resistance paint on a prime coat with Water base paint. Colour tinted tubes will be chosen to achieve the desired colour frame needed.

All metal works shall be painted with oil paint (Glyptal resien lacquer) in two coats.

A primary coat of antirust will be applied on all metal works before final painting is done.

Skirting shall be carried out in oil paint at the window sill level internally and 150cm externally with appropriate colours.

### 11 - OUTSIDE AMENITIES AND LAYOUT PLANNING

**Gutters**: To be excavated 40cm wide and 30cm deep at the rain drops. The walls of gutters are to be constructed in concrete and the floor will rolled and smoothen out with ordinary cement concrete providing a slope of 10% for the flow of water with an offshoot of at least 3m to the environment.

Prefabricated slabs of one meter twenty (1.20m) wide each shall be provided at the main

entrance of the classrooms at right angles.

Steps shall be constructed out of shaped stones at the main entrance to the building at 1,20m

wide as the case may be.

Equally, ramps of 1,20m cast in-situ of one twenty (1,20m) wide each with edges protected with angle bar of 25mm shall be provided at the entrance of the building for handicaps on wheel chairs or otherwise.

Flag stand and Flag pole with flag Shall be provided for the school. The stand shall be constructed with non-reinforced concrete 400kg/m3 with a height of 50cm. First step at 30cm

and a diameter of 1.5m at the first step and 70cm at the second step.

### 12 - PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT

The entrepreneur will propose to the control engineer, before the beginning of works, the place of his yard facilities and will request his authorization of installation.

The site must be chosen outside of the sensitive zones, in order to limit the site clearing, the extraction of bushes, the setting out of the building and general circulation.

The site must foresee an adequate drainage of waters on the whole surface. The maintenance areas and of washing should be concreted. These maintenance areas should have a slope toward a cesspool provided for the purpose and toward the inside of the platform in order to avoid the out-flow of the polluting products toward the site and the neighbourhood.

At the end the works, the entrepreneur will do all necessary works to the restoration of the various places of the site. The entrepreneur should fold all his material, and equipment. He should demolish all stationary installation, as foundation, support made of concrete or metallic, etc. in order to put back the site in its nearest initial state. No equipment nor materials should

be abandoned on the site, nor in the vicinity after the execution of all the works. Left-over materials are to be covered with a layer of earth, and the site has to receive an adequate drainage in order to avoid all erosion as the case may be.

### 13 - ORIGIN, QUALITY AND PREPARATION OF MATERIALS

The fine and coarse aggregates may either be from the river or quarry crushed and must be approved by the control engineer before any use on the site. The sand (0/5) shall have very fine elements settlement of less than 4%. The gravels (5/15 or 15/25) shall be clean and well graded with very fine elements settlement of less than 2%.

The cement shall be CPA 325 class from CEMENCAM or from an approved factory.

The reinforcement steel for reinforced concrete shall be of type HA FeE400 for the main reinforcement steel rods and round-smooth RL E235 for the stirrup rings.

Any fill material for the foundation and the surroundings structures shall have no particle dimension above 50mm and with plasticity index of less than 35. Fill materials shall also be free from organic elements and shall have a good granularity grading. No black vegetable soil shall be accepted for backfilling.

Stones for masonry works shall be of basalt, gneiss or granite type, be esthetical and should be gotten from the quarry or deposits approved by the control engineer with dimension sizes of not less than 20cm.

### 1) CONCRETE:

- -Ordinary concrete specifically lean concrete shall be 5cm thick and laid all round the excavated foundation trenches before the stone/block work is carried out and dosed at 150kg/m<sup>3</sup>.
- Over-site concrete shall be 8cm thick laid on the entire floors and paved area between walls and gutters dosed at 250kg/m<sup>3</sup> over a layer of stone hardcore.
- NB: The external veranda shall be 5cm below the level of the internal floor with 2% slope.
- -Reinforced concrete shall be specifically for pillars, beams damp proof course (DPC), lintels and ring beams and their mixture shall be in a proportion of 350kg/m<sup>3</sup>.
- NB: All concrete works should be properly cured (i.e. water three times a day for seven days)

- **Sand:** Will be free from oxide, organic material of animals or plant origin. Sieving shall vary from 0.08 2.5mm for mortar and other resisting surfaces like concrete structure shall vary from 0.16 5mm. It shall be river sand and nothing else.
- Aggregate: shall consist of natural and homogeneous materials or crushed stones. Tiny layer of grave (dust) shall be removed by sieving, blowing or washing.
- Water: To be used for the mixture mortar, concrete and washing of aggregates. Shall be clean and free from impurities; meaning potable water.
- **Cement:** To be used mostly for cement mortar, all concrete mixtures shall satisfy the general conditions laid down by regulation in force. It will be type CPA325 Portland cement and shall not show any trace of uneven mixture. Storage on the building site shall be done on a dry and ventilated floor. Any stock presenting an unsatisfactory pulverulent condition will be discarded and cleared away within four (04) days.
- Rods: shall be mild steel reinforcement, Tor or Steel in accordance with the R/C &3 rules. The steel shall be perfectly clean without any trace of rust, non-adhesive to paint or grease.
- **Shuttering:** hard wood, to bear without any noticeable distortion, the load and pressure of concrete, the effect of vibration and weight of workers involved in setting it up.
  - MASONRY:

-Blocks- Load bearing wall shall be mounted in compressed cement blocks of (15x20x40) cm for load bearing walls of PC300 Kg/m³ (at most 32 blocks per bag of cement). Blocks should show an appreciable degree of resistance to violent pressure.

### All blocks shall be cured for at least 14 days before being used.

-Plastering: All plastering shall be applied using a trowel, float, straights edges and sponge. Cement mortar mix in a proportion of 400kg/m³ will be used to plaster all previously rejoined areas on all masonry and concrete works, and then thinly floated. The final thickness of the plastering shall not be less (02cm). The external walls shall receive a coat of spata dash before plastering is done on it.

-Screed: a smooth layer of ordinary cement screed 400kg/m³ (1:2) finish shall be spread on the 8cm concrete floor and the screed shall be 3cm thick.

### 13 GUTTERS:

To be excavated 40cm wide and 30cm deep at the rain drops and to be provided particularly at the frontage and the two ends of the building as the topography of the terrain is relatively flat. The walls of gutters are to be constructed in concrete and the floor will be rolled and smoothen out with ordinary cement concrete providing a slope of 10% for the flow of water for level surfaces.

Prefabricated slabs of (1.20m) wide each shall be provided at the main entrance of the classrooms at right angles.

Equally **ramps** cast in-situ of (1.20m) wide each shall be provided at the entrance of the structure for handicaps on wheel chairs or otherwise.
