2. Nature of works:

8. Bid bond

12. Admissibility of bids

Under penalty of being rejected, the administrative documents required, must be produced in originals or true copies certified by the issuing service or administrative authorities must imperatively be produced in accordance with the Special Regulations/conditions of the invitation to tender.

They must not be older than three (03) months preceding the original date of submission of bids or must not have been established after the signing of the tender notice.

Any bid not incompliance with the prescriptions of the Tender File shall be declared inadmissible. Especially the absence of a bid bond issued by a first-rate bank approved by the Ministry in charge of Finance.

13. Opening of bids:

The bids shall be opened in a single (01) phase on Friday 20 June 2025 at 11am local time in the Conference Hall, at the Menji council office by the competent Tender board, in the presence of the bidders or duly authorized representatives having full knowledge of the file (power of attorney).

14. Evaluation criteria

i. Eliminatory criteria

Any bid not meeting with the requirements of the Tender File will be declared inadmissible. The eliminatory criteria are identified as follows:

- Forged documents in the Tender Files;
- ❖ History of bad execution of similar work or on-going legal suit with Government;
- Lack of bid bond or false bid bond;
- Absence of attestation of site visit signed by honour by the bidder;

- A technical score of less than 70%,
- Non-respect of 3 essential criteria;
- Suspension by MINMAP
- . Omission of a quantified unit price in the financial offer CAME
- Failure to in 48hrs make available a lacking administrative document
