Article 1: Objet

Article 9 : cautionnement de soumission

Sous peine de rejet, chaque soumissionnaire devra joindre à ses pièces administratives, un cautionnement de soumission timbré au tarif en vigueur émis par un établissement financier ou une institution financière de premier ordre agréé par le Ministère des finances accompagné d'un récépissé de consignation délivré par la caisse de dépôt et de consignations (CDEC) et portant la mention manuscrite de l'établissement émetteur de **un million (1.000.000) francs CFA** Valable pendant cent vingt (120) jours à compter de la date limite de dépôt des offres.

Une caution de soumission produite mais n'ayant aucun rapport avec l'Appel d'Offres concerné est considérée comme non conforme. La caution de soumission présentée par un soumissionnaire au cours de la séance d'ouverture des plis est irrecevable et considérée comme absente.

Article 10 : Ouverture des plis

L'ouverture des plis se fera en un temps à la salle de conférence du MINT le 09 SEPT 2026 à 14 heures par la Commission Interne de Passation des Marchés du MINT dans la salle de conférence du bâtiment rond de l'immeuble siège du Ministère des Transports.

Seuls les soumissionnaires peuvent assister à cette séance d'ouverture ou s'y faire représenter par une seule personne de leur choix dûment mandatée même en cas de groupement d'entreprises.

Article 11 : Délai de livraison

Le délai maximum de livraison prévu par le Maître d'Ouvrage est de trois (03) mois à compter de la date de notification de l'ordre de service prescrivant le démarrage des prestations.

Article 12 : Critères d'évaluation des offres

L'évaluation des Offres se fera au triple plan administratif, technique, et financier selon des critères éliminatoires, et selon les critères essentiels suivant le système binaire (oui/non).

Article 12.1 Critères éliminatoires

- L'Absence ou la non-conformité de la caution de soumission à l'ouverture des plis ;
- non -production au-delà du délai de 48 h après l'ouverture des plis, d'une pièce du dossier administratif jugée non conforme ou absente lors de l'ouverture des plis, (excepté le cautionnement de soumission);
- Document falsifié ou fausse déclaration ;
- L'Absence d'un prix unitaire quantifié dans l'offre financière ;
- Non-conformité du mode de soumission ;
- Non-respect du format de fichier des offres;
- Absence de la copie de sauvegarde en cas de dysfonctionnement de la plateforme COLEP'S.
- Non-respect de 80% des critères essentiels
- Absence de la charte d'intégrité datée et signée ;
- Absence de la déclaration d'engagement au respect des clauses environnementales et sociales datée et signée
- de l'absence d'un élément de l'offre financière (la soumission, les BPU, le DQE) ;
- Non-respect des modèles ou formulaires types prévus dans le DAO.

Article 1: Purpose

The Minister of Transport is launching an Open National Invitation to Tender for the acquisition of mobile calibration equipment.

Article 2: Scope of Services

The services consist of supplying calibration equipment, including training of user personnel.

Article 3: Participation and Origin

Participation in this Invitation to Tender is open to companies incorporated under Cameroonian law.

Article 4: Financing

The acquisition of supplies covered by this Invitation to Tender is financed by the Public Investment Budget of the Ministry of Transport, fiscal year 2026, budget line N°60 46 464 0 32000005 0411 524129, for an estimated amount of 55,000,000 (fifty-five million) CFA francs, all taxes included.

Article 5: Consultation of the Tender Documents

The Tender Documents may be consulted at the Ministry of Transport, Procurement Service, door C120, Tel. (237) 222 23 31 73, as soon as this notice is published.
The electronic version is available on the COLEPS platform at <http://www.marchespublics.cm> and <http://www.publicscontracts.cm> as soon as this notice is published.

Article 6: Purchase of the Tender Documents

The Tender Documents may be obtained from the Ministry of Transport, Procurement Service, as soon as this notice is published, upon presentation of a payment receipt to the Public Treasury for a non-refundable sum of 60,000 (sixty thousand) CFA francs.

It is also possible to obtain the Tender Documents by free download from the COLEP'S platform available at the addresses indicated above for the electronic version. However, online submission is conditional upon payment of the fees for purchasing the Tender Documents.

Article 7: File Size and Format

For online submission, the maximum sizes of the documents to be transmitted on the platform, constituting the bidder's offer, are as follows:

- 5 MB for the Administrative Bid;
- 15 MB for the Technical Bid;
- 5 MB for the Financial Bid.

Accepted formats are as follows:

- PDF format for text documents;
- JPEG for images.

Candidates should use compression software where necessary to reduce the size of files to be transmitted.

Article 8: Submission of Bids

The bid must be submitted by the bidder on the COLEP'S platform no later than 09 SEPT 2026 at 1:00 p.m. A backup copy of the bid saved on a USB drive or CD/DVD, along with the online submission receipt, must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly and legibly marked "backup copy," in addition to the notation below, to the Procurement Service within the required deadlines.

Article 9: Bid Bond

Under penalty of rejection, each bidder must include with their administrative documents a bid bond, stamped at the rate in effect, issued by a first-rate financial institution approved by the Ministry of Finance, accompanied by a deposit receipt issued by the Deposit and Consignment Fund (CDEC) and bearing the handwritten notation of the issuing institution, in the amount of one million (1,000,000) CFA francs, valid for one hundred twenty (120) days from the deadline for submission of bids.

A bid bond submitted that has no connection to the relevant Invitation to Tender shall be considered non-compliant. A bid bond presented by a bidder during the bid opening session shall be inadmissible and considered absent.

Article 10: Bid Opening

The bid opening will take place in a single session in the MINT conference room on 09 SEPT 2026 -- at 2:00 p.m., by the MINT Internal Procurement Commission, in the conference room of the round building of the Ministry of Transport headquarters.

Only bidders may attend this opening session or be represented by a single duly authorized person of their choosing, even in the case of a consortium of companies.

Article 11: Delivery Deadline

The maximum delivery period set by the Contracting Authority is three (3) months from the date of notification of the service order prescribing the start of services.

Article 12: Bid Evaluation Criteria

Bids will be evaluated on three levels — administrative, technical, and financial — based on eliminatory criteria, and based on the following essential criteria under a binary (yes/no) system.

Article 12.1 Eliminatory Criteria

- Absence or non-compliance of the bid bond at the time of bid opening;
- Failure to produce, within 48 hours after bid opening, an administrative document deemed non-compliant or absent at the time of bid opening (except for the bid bond);
- Falsified document or false declaration;
- Absence of a quantified unit price in the financial bid;
- Non-compliance with the submission method;
- Non-compliance with the file format of the bids;
- Absence of the backup copy in the event of a malfunction of the COLEP'S platform;
- Failure to meet 80% of the essential criteria;
- Absence of the dated and signed integrity charter;
- Absence of the dated and signed declaration of commitment to comply with environmental and social clauses;
- Absence of any element of the financial bid (the bid form, the Unit Price Schedule, the Detailed Quantity Estimate);
- Non-compliance with the standard templates or forms provided in the Tender Documents.

Article 12.2: Essential Criteria

- Overall presentation of the bid
- Company experience and references
- Qualifications and competence of personnel
- Logistical resources
- Financing capacity of fifteen million (15,000,000) [CFA francs]
- Proof of acceptance of contract conditions (Special Administrative Clauses, Special Technical Clauses, contract template initialed and signed, dated on the last page)
- After-sales service
- Delivery methodology and schedule

Article 13: Award Method

The contract will be awarded to the bidder whose bid meets the required administrative, technical, and financial qualification criteria and whose bid is evaluated as the lowest, including any proposed discounts where applicable.

Article 14: Validity Period of Bids

Bidders remain bound by their bids for a period of ninety (90) days from the deadline for submission of bids.

Article 15: Discounts

To be taken into account, any discounts granted must be stated in both words and figures, and not handwritten, on the bid submission letter.

Article 16: Submission Method

The submission method adopted for this Invitation to Tender is online submission exclusively.

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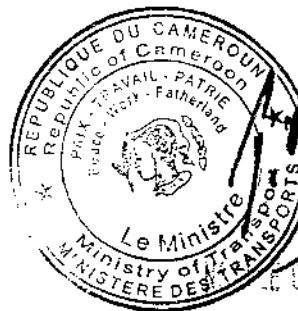
